

Creation Master List of Supplies

Items to Bring Every Week

Print One Copy From the Site for the Quarter:

- Attendance Chart
- Assemble the Teacher Creation Booklet and bring to every class
- Binder Cover Front – to put on the front of the Binder for Teacher
- Creation Outline for Binder
- Dear Teacher to put in front of the Binder for Teacher
- Bibles – enough for everyone to have one
- Pens/Pencils/Crayons/Pencil Crayons
- Stickers (for attendance)
- Glue Sticks and Scissors to Share
- Binder with Lesson and Activities printed inside

Additional Items for Week 1

Print From the Site:

- Creation Take Home Sheet (One for each student to show parents)
- Creation Box Cutout Pictures (precut before class, one per student) **OR**
- Create your own bulletin board Days of Creation - see picture for ideas
- Small Cardboard Box (1 for every 4 students)
Will need 6 boxes of various sizes in total to stack on top of each other to represent the days of Creation.
- Flashlight (Or flashlight from phone)



Optional Supplies

Print From the Site:

- Dark and Light Coloring Sheet (one per student)
- Oreo Cookies for “Dark and Light” Snack and Napkins

Additional Items for Week 2

Print From the Site:

- God is Powerful Sheet (one for each child)
- Box Cutout Template for Day 2 (1 for every child)

Other Items to Bring:

- One sheet of newspaper for each child
- Small cardboard box (1 box for every 4 students) (larger than week before)

Optional Supplies:

- Cotton balls and blue tissue paper (Box creation of day two activity)
- White Balloons (5) (Balloons are for the dividing water game)
- Blue Balloons (5)
- Deflated balloons (one for each child)
- Paper towel (one for each child)
- Paper cup (one for each child)
- Small bucket (big enough to hold a paper cup)
- Water to place in bucket
- Towel to dry spills, if needed
- Marshmallow (one for each child) if doing snack
- Graham cracker (one for each child) if doing snack

Additional Items for Week 3

Print From the Site:

- Student Creation Booklet (one for each child)
- Box Cutout Template for Day 3 (1 for every child)

Other Items to Bring:

- Medium cardboard box (1 box for 4 students) (larger than week before)

Optional Supplies:

Print From the Site:

- Cube Dice Templates – print on white cardstock paper cut out and glue or tape together before class
- Sunflower Page (one for each child)
- Snack – various fruit and vegetables with napkins

Additional Items for Week 4

Print From the Site:

- Box Cutout Template for Day 4 (1 for every 2 children)
- Creation Board Game Printed on White Cardstock Paper
- Copy of Questions (attached to Board Game Sheet)

Items to Bring From Previous Lesson Plan:

- Student Creation Booklet (one for each child)

Other Items to Bring:

- Medium cardboard box (1 box for 4 students) (larger than week before)
- Game Pieces (1 for each student) – coins, candies, or buttons
- Dice – one per board game

Optional Supplies:

- Snack – Sun and Moon or Star shaped snacks like cheese, apple slices, or crackers. Or a small paper cup of whip cream and have kids drop in butterscotch chips as stars, eat with spoon.
- Cotton balls for clouds on Box Creation Day 4
- Candy or sticker prizes for everyone who plays Creation Board Game

Additional Items for Week 5

Print From the Site:

- Box Cutout Template for Day 5 (1 for every student)
- Creation Clothes Pin Game Template (1 set cut out before class)

Items to Bring From Previous Lesson Plan:

- Student Creation Booklet (one for each child)

Other Items to Bring:

- Medium-Large cardboard box (1 box for 4 students)
- Shoe Box with White Paper Wrapped Around (See Creation Game Directions)
- Clothes Pin (12)

Optional Supplies:

- Snack – Fish Crackers or Sunflower Seeds (pretend bird seed)
- I Spy Pictures (1 set cut out before class)

Additional Items for Week 6

Print From the Site:

- Box Cutout Template for Day 6 (1 for every student)
- Match the thing to its home sheet (one for each student)

Items to Bring From Previous Lesson Plan:

- Student Creation Booklet (one for each child)

Other Items to Bring:

- Large cardboard box (1 box for 4 students)

Optional Supplies:

- Snack – Animal Crackers or Gingerbread Men
- Creation Memory Match (print two sets of each on white cardstock or construction paper and cut out before class)

Additional Items for Week 7

Print From the Site:

- Good Creation Verses – (1 for each student)
- God is Good Activity Sheet – (1 for each student)
- God is Good Lyric Sheet – (1 for teacher to show)

Optional Supplies:

- Snack – Fruit and/or Vegetable Slices
- Soft Ball to share
- Three different things from each category: Things that taste good, feel good to touch, smell good, look good, sound good. (Ex: cookies, grapes, bananas) (Fuzzy teddy bear, soft flower, squishy ball) (Rose, mint, orange) (Flowers, picture of a puppy, picture of nature) (Sounds of birds, song, sound of a river or kids playing)
- Cloth Blindfold or Scarf
- Sheet or towel to cover items

Additional Items for Week 8

Print from the Site:

- Earth Puzzle – printed on white Cardstock paper (1 per student)
- Maze Activity sheets (1 per student)
- Name Ways to Take Care of God's Creation Page (1 per student)

Optional Supplies:

- Snack – Fruit and/or Vegetable Slices
- Sandwich baggies to put puzzle pieces in after kids cut the puzzle out – one per student
- Sharpie pen to put each child's name on the sandwich baggie – to share

Additional Items for Week 9

Print from the Site:

- God's Animals Activity Sheets (one for each student)
- God Cares for Creation Bible Verses (one for each student)

Optional Supplies:

- Snack – Carrot and/or Apple Slices

Additional Items for Week 10

Print from the Site:

- Creation Match (one for each student)
- Creation Maze (one for each student)

Other Items to Bring:

Cookies Decorating – Check for allergies of students first!

- Premade cookies *made or purchased in advance (4 per student)
- Icing – try to have two different colors in small bowls to share
- Plastic knives to spread icing (one per student)
- Plastic spoons one for each bowl of candies, chocolate chips, etc.
- Chocolate chips in small bowl to share
- Sprinkles or small M&M candies to decorate cookies
- Damp paper towels or wet wipes (one per student)
- Paper plates (2 for each student)
- Plastic wrap to wrap plate and three cookies.

Optional Supplies:

- Snack – Left over cookies made from gift activity

Additional Items for Week 11

Print from the Site:

- Mom or Grandma Card – each student chooses one. Print on white cardstock

Other Items to Bring:

Flower Pot with Live Plant

- Small flowering plant with pot that can be decorated - one for each student
- Wax or colored paper – one small piece per student to wrap around the base of flower pot to ensure dirt/water doesn't spill
- Various stickers – hearts, flowers, thanks, etc. – enough to share
- Sharpie pen – one to share to write on flower pot
- Elastic band – one per student to fit over flower pot to hold wax paper in place

OR

- Ribbon – one piece per student to wrap around flower pot and make a bow

Optional Supplies:

- Snack – Your choice

Print from the Site:

- Showing Love Sheet – one per student
- My Mom Word Search – one per student

Additional Items for Week 12

Print from the Site:

- Decipher the Verse – one per student
- Jesus Before Creation – one per student

Items to Bring from Previous Lesson Plan:

- Creation Match Game (from lesson 6) or if you didn't prepare – print on white cardstock paper and cut out two sets for class to share.

Optional Supplies:

- Snack – Squeezable Honey and Graham Crackers or Biscuits

Additional Items for Week 13

Print from the Site:

- Creation Word Search – one per student

Items to Bring from Previous Lesson Plan:

- Creation Board Game (from lesson 4) or if you didn't prepare – print on white cardstock paper and cut out two sets for class to share.

Other Items to Bring:

- Popcorn in paper bags – one bag for each student
- Game pieces – one for each student (Could be pennies, candies, buttons)
- Dice – one per board game

Optional Supplies:

- Snack – Popcorn in paper bags – see above
- Blanket and pillows – if you want them to really enjoy their time of “rest”
- Stickers or candy prizes for Creation Game – one for each student
