## Items to Bring Every Week

Print One Copy From the Site for the Quarter:

- Attendance Chart
- Binder Cover Front – to put on the front of the Binder for Teacher
- Creation Outline for Binder
- Dear Teacher to put in front of the Binder for Teacher
- Bibles – enough for everyone to have one
- Pens/Pencils/Crayons/Pencil Crayons

### Additional Items for Week 6

Print From the Site:

- I Will Walk with God Activity Sheet – one per student
- Noah & Flood Word Search – one per older student
- Noah & Flood Pictures – one set per younger student

Other Items to Bring:

- Washable Finger Paint or Ready-made Chocolate Pudding – enough for children to share – very small amount needed.
- Wet Wipes or Small bucket of Warm Soapy Water – to wash hands when done
- Small Bowls for Paints or Puddings – one for each student
- Roll of Newspaper or Table Cloth – to protect table
- Old Adult Shirts – for students to wear to protect their clothes
- Spoons – one per student if using chocolate pudding

\*\*\*IF you cannot get supplies for finger painting – let students use crayons instead

### **CHOOSE EITHER:**

- Noah Color Page and
- Noah Sticker Activity Sheet – one set per student **OR**
- Fruit Loops Craft – Fruit Loops Cereal (or dried or fresh bite sized fruit in rainbow colors (ex: grapes, bananas, blueberries, orange slices, etc.) – enough for each student to make a rainbow on their paper plate (see image here)
- Icing – premade or homemade – one small container per 6 children
- Paper Plates – 2 per student
- Parchment Paper/Wax Paper – one piece to cover each paper plate
- Tablespoon to hand out icing
- Wet Wipes or Wet Paper Towels – to clean hands

(Optional for Fruit Loops – have students just make cereal rainbows on 1 paper plate and when finished, take a plastic zip-to-close bag to stick student’s cereal in to take)

- Scissors (for teacher to cut Rainbow Sheet)
