

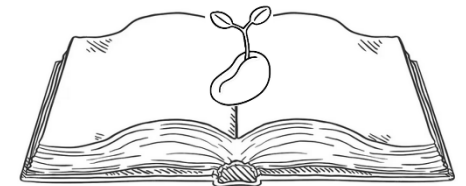
Jesus' Parables Take Home Sheet

Go through one of the following parables each week for the next eight weeks.

Parables	Bible Reading	Lesson
1. Four Soils	Matthew 13:1-23, Mark 4:1-20, Luke 8:1-18	All hear the Word but only good soil accepts
2. Wise and Foolish Builders	Matthew 7:21-29, Luke 6:43-49	Good soil is wise by obeying Christ
3. Weeds and Mustard Seed	Matthew 13:24-43	The wise know God is in control
4. Hidden Treasure & the Pearl	Matthew 13:44-46	The wise recognize the value of God's Kingdom
5. Unforgiving Servant	Matthew 18:21-35	The wise forgive since forgiven
6. Lost Sheep, Coin, and Sons	Luke 15	The wise rejoice over repentance
7. Late and Early Laborers	Matthew 20:1-16	The wise share God's Kingdom
8. The Talents	Matthew 25	The wise are prepared and willing to work

Pray: That God will help you and your family to understand the parables and be the good soil that is pure in heart, wise, obedient to God, remembers the warnings, values the Kingdom, forgives and seeks forgiveness, repent, submits, shares in the joy of others being added to the Kingdom, is willing to bring others into the Kingdom, and is prepared by studying His Word and doing it all the days of your life.



Do: Each week look at the lesson in the parable and pray and do things that relate to it.

1. Pray that you and others will be the good soil.
2. Do things that show good soil each week related to the parable you are learning. Preparing for Sunday School, reading Bible, being kind, remembering the warnings God gives, forgiving, repenting, etc.
3. Find a way to share with someone what you learned during Sunday School and tell them about it. Tell a friend, family member, teacher, or someone else what you learned from Jesus each week!
4. Find a way to help remember what good soil is and what good soil does: Review your activity sheets, pick an activity each week that helps you remember the lesson you learned. Practice your memory verses, draw pictures of the Kingdom and all it includes in it – the King, citizens who obey the King, and all the good values and laws the Kingdom has, etc.
