

Lesson 13

God Made Eve

Objective

Students will understand that God made Eve on Day 6, after creating Adam.

Supplies

Teachers and/or Coordinators ensure supplies are ready prior to each class.

1) Introduction to Lesson

As students enter, welcome them and help them find a chair to sit at. Thank them for coming. Take attendance. Let each child put a sticker beside their name for this week.

Do you remember what we talked about last week? We talked about Adam the first man and we made a puppet of him. Today we are going to talk about Eve – the first woman that God created on Day 6. And we will also make a puppet of her, so you will have both Adam and Eve! But first, let's sing some songs about Adam and Eve:

God Made Me

God made the sun, (Raise arms in a circle over head.)
God made the tree, (Spread arms out to indicate branches.)
God made you, (Point to another person)
And God made me! (Point to self.)
God made Adam. (Point to the boys.)
God made Eve. (Point to the girls.)
God made you, and God made me. (Point to others and then yourself.)

In the Beginning

Tune: Farmer in the Dell
God made the world*. God made the world*.
In the beginning, God made the world*.
(replace world with other words each time. *light, sea, sky, animals, etc)
The man's name was Adam. (Boys stand and sit)
The woman's name was Eve. (Girls stand and sit.)
In the beginning, God made Adam and Eve.

2) Class Time - Genesis 2:18-25

5 minutes

*Optional - Before class, get a story book that shows pictures of Eve or use a felt board with pictures if available.

Eve was the first woman God created. Let's turn to Genesis Chapter 2. Listen as I read Genesis 2:19-23. Read the account of Adam and Eve in the Bible, make sure to stop and show visual aids if you have them as you get to that part of the account.

Eve was created on the 6th day; after God had created the land and seas, the sun, moon, stars, plants, trees, and all the animals and Adam. So Adam and Eve had everything he needed to survive. Adam and Eve were very special to God and God loved them very much – just like God loves you very much!

Eve was formed from Adam's rib – God made sure that Adam fell asleep so it wouldn't

hurt him and he closed up the place where He took the rib nice and quick so Adam didn't feel anything. When Adam woke up – there was Eve; his new helper!

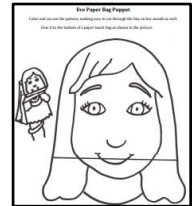
God put Adam and Eve in a beautiful garden. Adam and Eve were very happy in the garden. God gave them several jobs. One was to take care of the garden and to take care of each other.

Who do you help take care of? Do you have a pet, a brother or sister, or a friend that you help? That makes God very happy when we help others and when we take care of what God has given us. That includes taking good care of our clothes, toys, room, and anything we are blessed with. If we take good care of those things, God will add more to our life. Just like Adam and Eve we need to help others and help take care of what God has blessed us with!

3) Activity - Eve Paper Bag Puppet Craft

10-15 minutes

Hand each student a “Eve Puppet Template,” some crayons, glue and scissors. Start by having them color the picture. Next, help the students cut out Eve- including cutting a straight line across where it's indicated by her mouth. Hand everyone a paper lunch bag and help them flip the bag upside down so they can glue the template to the bag. Making sure to glue Eve's face to the bottom of the bag and her shoulders, ect to the underneath part so that the bag acts as a puppet. (See picture for help)



Say: **last week we made Adam and this week we made his new friend and helper that God gave Adam – her name was Eve and she became Adam's wife!**

**If you kept the Adam puppet from last week, allow the children to put one puppet on each hand and have Adam and Eve talk to each other and “get to know” each other.*

Ask the students **in what ways Eve could help Adam?** (help with animals, the garden, getting food, etc.)

Who made Eve? God did!

How was she made? From the rib of Adam

What was her job? To help Adam.

4) Activity - Eve Book Craft

10-15 minutes

Hand each student a “Eve Book Craft” sheet, crayons and scissors.

As the students color, read the pages aloud in order. Then help the students cut out the pages.

Once the pages are cut out then staple each page together, starting with page 1 at the top of the pile and page 6 being last. Put two staples, one at the top left and one at the bottom left to make a booklet they can keep and read to remind them that God made Eve – the first woman!



5) Activity - Eve Color Page

10 minutes

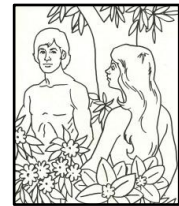
Hand each student a “Eve Color Page” with crayons.

While the students are coloring, remind them that **God made Adam and Eve on Day 6 and that Eve was the first woman that was created to help Adam.**

Who made Eve? God did

How was she made? From the rib of Adam

What was her job? To help Adam



6) Optional Activity - Sing

5-10 minutes

Practice songs sung earlier or find different songs in Songs for Winter Quarter

7) Optional Snack - Animal Crackers

5 minutes

Hand each student some animal crackers.

Say, **Today we learned about who? Eve, the first woman that God created and lived in the Garden of Eden and was Adam's helper!**

Today as we snack on animal crackers, let's name the different animals we see that God created while we eat. After snack, have students clean up.

8) Closing Prayer

**Before the prayer, make sure the activities/snacks have been cleaned up.

Ask if there are any prayers the students want to share. Say closing prayer remembering to thank God for making men and women and for giving us everything we need including our food and helpers in our life.
