

Winter Creation Master List of Supplies: All activity sheets or templates are on C.D.

Make sure teacher has the following supplies every week plus the ones specific for the week they are teaching.

- Pens/Pencils
- Bible (please bring your own)
- Crayons/Pencil Crayons
- Attendance Sheets
- Stickers – enough for each child to have one every lesson for 13 lessons

Week 1:

- God is Good Color Page - one sheet per child
- Creation Book – one for class to share, printed before class

Optional Activities

- Visual Aids of Creation – story books, pictures, small animals, etc.
- Creation Fans Template – one set per child and teacher cut out before class
- Popsicle or Craft Sticks – 5 per child taped to each fan – done before class
- Tape
- Soft Ball
- Three of each kind of category – Good things that have a good taste, touch, smell, sight, sound (ex: apples, grapes, chocolate, fuzzy teddy bear, leaves, twig, water or snow (in small bowl), pictures of things – no blind fold for this one, and/or sound of birds)
- cloth blindfold
- God is So Good Lyrics Sheet – one for class to see if needed
- Creation memory match print one set for every two children on cardstock paper so they can't see through the paper and figure out the card before even looking 😊
- Snack – fruit and vegetable pieces
- Napkins
- Cups with water
- Play Dough – create animals and people enough for children to share
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

Week 2:

- Glue sticks
- Scissors (1 for each child)
- Everything God Made is Good Color Activity Sheet – one per child
- Stickers for Color Sheet – 12 stickers per page – one sticker per child

Optional Activities

- Visual Aids of Creation – story books, pictures, small animals, etc.
- 1 balloon for every 2 students - inflated before class and tied with a knot. Draw a bird face on each one – see below for directions.
- Sharpie or permanent marker to draw on balloons
- Soft Ball – if playing Hot Potato Game
- Snack – fruit and vegetable pieces
- Napkins
- Cups with water
- God is Good lyrics
- God's Good Creation Color Page or Visual Aid – one page per child if doing color page or one page to show class if using as a visual

Week 3:

- Bird Template – printed out on white Cardstock – one for each child
- White Cardstock for background Bird Craft activity – one for each child
- Scissors (one pair for each child) or if small children cut out bird template before class
- Glue Stick (one for each child or for every two children)
- God Cares – Bible Verses to show children – one sheet per class
- Taking Care of Animals God Made – Find and Color Activity Sheet

Optional Activities

- Animals (stuffed animals of various kinds) – enough so every child can play with some
- Googly eyes (one pair for each bird)
- Feathers (to glue on bird) or tissue paper pieces balled up to make “feathers” using glue to stick them to the bird.
- Play Dough – enough for children to share
- Animals and Creation Color Page or Visual Aid – one per child if coloring, or one per class to show children a picture of animals God made during Creation
- Snack - gummy worms and celery – enough to share
- Napkins
- Cups with water

Week 4:

- God’s Animals Activity Sheets (one for each child)

God’s Winter Animals – Reindeer Child’s Hand Print Craft:

- Cardboard piece – 12 inches x 12 inches – one piece per child making sure the front side has no writing and is smooth
- Twigs – 12 inches x 12 inches each approximately - 4 per child
- Chocolate Pudding – make enough so the pudding will fill a plate and each child can place their hands on the plate and use the pudding as finger paints
- Fluffy pom pom for Reindeer nose – one per child (if unavailable use scrunched up tissue paper or a red marker to draw a nose)
- Googly Eyes Large – two per child (if unavailable draw Reindeer Eyes with Marker)
- Twine or string – 16 inches long – one per child
- Hot Glue Gun and Glue or white glue – Adults only should use the glue gun and hot glue and glue twigs on for children
- Ribbon – enough for each child to make a bowtie for the reindeer
- Marker – to write name and year on front of cardboard – to share

Optional Activities

- God Created the Animals Color Page (one for each child)
- Stuffed Animals – various kinds for children to play with
- One balloon for every two children, inflated before class and tied close
- Sharpie pen to write bird face on balloons – see below for instructions.
- Snack - gummy worms and celery
- Napkins
- Cups with water

Week 5:

- Color and Name ways to take care of God’s creation page (one for each child)
- Earth Puzzle – printed on white Cardstock paper (one for each child)
- Scissors (one for each child)

Optional Activities

- One balloon for every child – inflated before class
- Snack – fruit and veggie pieces
- Napkins
- Cups with water or milk to drink
- Sandwich baggies to put puzzle pieces in after kids cut the puzzle out
- Sharpie pen to put each child’s name on the sandwich baggie and to draw a bird face on the balloons

Week 6:

- Paper lunch bags - one for each child
- Different-texture nature item for inside each bag - such as a smooth leaf, a thistle, a pine branch, garden soil, a feather, a rock and a piece of animal fur
- Blank Paper – one for each child to draw on

Optional Activities

- Snack – fruit and veggie pieces
 - Napkins
 - Cups with water or milk to drink
 - One balloon for every two children inflated before class and tied close
 - Sharpie pen to write bird face on balloons
- Color Page or Visual Aid – one sheet per child if doing coloring, or one sheet for class if showing students what God made on the earth.

Week 7:

- Creation Fan Templates – one set per child (if kept from lesson 1 use again) or print again
- Popsicle sticks – one per fan per child
- 4 sugar cookies or shortbread cookies per child to decorate as gifts *made in advance.
- Icing – try to have two colors in yogurt sized containers.
- Plastic knives to spread icing (one for each child)
- Plastic spoons – one for each bowl of candies or sprinkles
- Chocolate chips in small bowl to decorate cookies
- Sprinkles or small M&M's to decorate cookies
- Damp paper towels to help with cleaning sticky fingers or Wet Wipes
- Paper plates (two for each child) one to put cookie being decorated and one to put finished cookies to be wrapped as gift.
- Saran wrap to wrap paper plate and three cookies
- God Made Babies Color Page – one per child
- God Made Babies Dog Toy to cut out and glue onto color page – one per child 4 on a page
- String – 6 inch piece for each child
- Tape to share
- Scissors to share or cut out dog toy in advance before class if doing

Optional Activities

- Dolls of family members for children to see and play with – enough to share
- Books that show families and people helping others – enough to share
- God Created Man Color Page or Visual – one per child if doing as a color page, or one for the class to share if showing a picture while reading about God's Creation - Man
- Snack: Left over cookies made from gift activity!
- Napkins
- Cups with water

Week 8:

- Ways to Praise God Activity Sheet – one per child
- Fruit of My Lips Being Thankful Drawing Sheet (one per child)

Optional Activities

- God Made Us Activity Sheet – one per child
- God Made Us Sticker – 12 on a sheet – one animal for each child
- Gluesticks – to share
- Ball or Hacky Sac to pass around – one per class
- Snack: Fruit Pieces – enough for each child
- Napkins
- Cups with water

Week 9:

- Creation book if you have one – to show pictures as you read from Bible, or use Creation fans from lesson 1
- Jesus Before Creation Color Page

Optional Activities

- Snack – squeezable honey and graham crackers
- Napkins
- Cups with water
- Creation Match Game Template – either from lesson 6 if you did or print and cut out cards before class print on cardstock or construction paper

Week 10:

- Action Game “Night” Template – one per class printed on white paper
- Action Game “Day” Template – one per class printed on white paper
- Cube Activity Template – one per 4 children – print on white paper and cut and make into a cube before class
- Sunflower Color Page – one per child to go with Cube Activity
- Activity Game Template of Sun, Moon and Stars – one set per class printed on white paper
- Tape to hang template pictures
- Creation Clothes Pin Game Template pieces cut out before class
- Shoe Box with White paper wrapped around (see Creation Game directions)

- Clothes pins (12)

Optional Activities

- White Balloons (5) (Balloons are for the dividing water game)
- Blue Balloons (5)
- Pictures cut out of birds and fish for “I spy”
- Snack: Fruit or Veggie Pieces – enough for each child
- Napkins
- Cups with water

Week 11:

- Plastic bottles with labels removed (may need to wash sticky glue off first) – one per child
- Ribbon – one per child to tie a bow on bottle
- Construction Paper – cut in half – one half for each child to draw a message for the bottle
- Construction Paper – cut in half – one half for each child to cover paper towel roll butterfly
- Toilet Paper Roll – clean and empty – one per child
- Pipe Cleaners – one per child cut in half for butterfly antennae
- Scrap construction paper and stickers to decorate butterfly
- Butterfly wing template – 2 per page – one set per child – printed on colored construction paper
- Glue sticks or glue to share
- Tape to share
- Heart or appropriate shaped stickers – 5-10 per child
- Ways to Care Drawing Sheet – one per child

Optional Activities

- Bean bags or soft small ball to pass around – one per class
- Candies to go into message in a bottle craft – small enough to fit in bottle, big enough for little ones not to choke
- Snack - Strawberry slices or cheese, cut into heart shapes – enough for each child
- Napkins
- Cups with water

Week 12:

- Adam Paper Bag Template – one sheet per child
- Paper lunch bag –one per child
- Adam’s Garden Background Color Page – one per child
- Adam’s Garden Sticker Color and Cut Out Page – 2 sets per page – one set per child
- Glue Sticks to share
- Scissors to share

Optional Activities

- Jar of dirt
- Adam Names the Animals Color Sheet – one per child
- Snack: Animal Crackers
- Napkins
- Cups with water

Week 13:

- Eve – Paper Bag Template – one per child
- Paper Lunch Bags – one per child
- Scissors to share
- Glue to share
- The First Woman Color Book Template – one per child
- Stapler or tape to share

Optional Activities

- Eve Color Page – one per child or use as a visual aid
- Snack: Animal Crackers – enough for each child
- Napkins
- Cups with water
