

Spring God and Families in Genesis Master List of Supplies: All activity sheets or templates are on C.D.

Make sure teacher has the following supplies every week plus the ones specific for the week they are teaching.

- Pens/Pencils
- Bible
- Crayons/Pencil Crayons

Week 1:

- Glue sticks
- Scissors to cut out paper dolls
- Adam and Eve Have a Family Color Page
- Adam and Eve with Sons Paper Doll and Clothes Templates – one set for each child - printed on white cardstock paper and cut out before class. Or you can use dolls if available below in optional activities

Optional Activities

- Soft Ball
- Dolls of Man and Women and children along with clothes to dress them – enough for children to share and pretend to be Adam and his family
- Twine or string cut into small pieces for hair if doing paper doll activity
- Cain and Abel Activity Page – one per child
- Scissors to share or cut out Activity Page before class
- Tape to Share
- Green Construction Paper – one sheet per class to tear into pieces as grass
- Glue to share
- Snack – fruit and vegetable pieces
- Napkins
- Cups with water or milk
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

Week 2:

- Scissors to cut out Puppets – if want you can cut out before class
- Stick Puppet Templates – one set per child printed on white cardstock or construction paper
- Popsicle Sticks or Craft Sticks – 5 per child
- Home Color Page and Background for Stick Puppets – one per child

Optional Activities

- Soft Ball
- Visual Aids of Noah and the Ark – story books, pictures, small ark with animals, etc.
- Adam and Eve Home Maze Sheet – one per child
- God Gave Us Homes Color and Sticker Page – one per child
- Glue to share
- Scissors to share
- Brooms, Dusters and/or Dust Clothes – enough for children to share
- Snack – Square Crackers – 4 per child to make a leaning house
- Napkins
- Cups with water or milk
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

Week 3:

- Glue sticks and/or Tape
- Scissors- if want you can cut out objects before class or during
- Circle the Food that is the Same Activity Sheet – one per child
- God Gives Us Food Sandwich Craft Template – one per child
- God Gives Us Good Food Color Page – one per child

Optional Activities

- Visual Aids of Noah and the Ark – story books, pictures, small ark with animals, etc.
- God Gives Us Food Trace the Figs Sheet – one per child
- Basket or Paper Bag – one for each child
- Pictures cut out from God Gives Us Food Color Page – one set per child cut out after they have colored the picture (see above)
- Snack – Fruit or Vegetable Pieces – enough for each child to have some
- Napkins
- Cups with water or milk
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

Week 4:

- Ways God Gives Us Water Activity Sheet – one per child
- Ways We Use Water Naming Sheet – one per class to see
- God Gives Us Water in the Ocean Color Page – one per child

Optional Activities

- Visual Aids of Adam in the Garden of Eden – story books, pictures, etc.
- Find the Differences Water Sheet – one per child
- Balloon or Foam Football decorated with marker to look like a fish – one for class
- Permanent Marker – to decorate pretend fish
- Blue towel, blanket or tissue paper to put over basket
- Bubbles – enough for teacher and assistant to blow bubbles while children play
- Small Tub or Water Proof Bucket – one for class to share
- Water
- Towels to keep floor dry
- Items that sink or float – rock, toy boat, Styrofoam, glass bottle, pool toys, etc.
- Basket – large enough to hold items below – one for class to share
- Items of different things we use with water. Example Toothbrush, small toy boat, cup, water bottle, swimming suit, tub toys, soap, fishing pole, shampoo, pool toys, etc.
- Snack – soup or biscuits – something that requires us to add water to it to make it what it is - enough for each child to have some
- Napkins
- Cups with water
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

Week 5:

- God Gives Us Clothes Color Page – one per child
- Scissors to share
- Paper Doll Templates – one doll for each child – 3 dolls printed on a page - printed on white cardstock paper and cut out before class.
- Paper Doll Clothes – one set printed and cut out before class to use as trace for doll clothes onto textured fabrics.
- Glue Sticks or White Glue to share
- Textured Fabrics like felt sheets, sand paper, foam pieces, etc. – To use to trace doll clothing template to make “textured” clothes for the students

Optional Activities

- Visual Aids of Adam in the Garden of Eden – story books, pictures, etc.
- Dolls of Man and Women and children along with clothes to dress them – enough for children to share and pretend to be Adam and his family

- Basket – large enough to hold items below – one for class to share
- Items of different things we wear. Example shirt, socks, hat, gloves, shoes, dress, pants, belt, scarf, etc.
- Dress up adult clothes for children to dress up in – example – shoes, scarf, purse, ties, etc. are all great fun for kids to dress up in.
- Twine or Yarn – cut to small pieces as an option to add to the color page or to paper doll hair
- Sidewalk Chalk – one for teacher to draw Hopscotch Game outside if weather is nice
- Stone – one small stone to use to mark spot on hopscotch game
- Snack – Cookies or Cheese cut out in shapes of clothes – enough for each child
- Napkins
- Cups with water or water
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

Week 6:

- Glue sticks and/or Tape
- Scissors- to share
- God is Great Crown Page – one per child
- Stickers, foam pieces, scrap paper, string, ribbon or jewels to decorate crown
- God is Great He Made Our World Color and Activity Page – one per child

Optional Activities

- Visual Aids of Creation – story books, pictures, small animals, etc.
- Creation Fans Template – one set per child and teacher cut out before class
- Popsicle or Craft Sticks – 5 per child taped to each fan – done before class
- Tape to share
- Soft Ball for class to share
- Snack – Fruit or Vegetable Pieces – enough for each child to have some
- Napkins
- Cups with water or milk
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

Week 7:

- Match the Baby Animal to Its Mother Page – one per child
- Noah and His Family Build the Ark Color Page – one per child
- Study the Picture Sheet – one for class to share

Optional Activities

- Story book or pictures of Noah and the Flood to show kids if available and/or Flannel Display Board or animal teddy bears with ark with Noah and the Flood Characters, etc. *See Coordinator to see if these types of materials are available at your church.

- Play dough – to share

Snack:

- Fruit Loops Cereal or Skittles candies - enough to share
- Napkins

Week 8:

- Glue to share
- Scissors to share
- Noah and the Ark Sticker Sheet – 4 sets of stickers per page - one set of stickers per child cut out before class
- Noah and the Ark Sticker Color Page – one per child

Optional Activities

- Noah and the Ark Color Page – one per student
- Paper pieces for writing on (small) – one per pair of students (game)
- Salt Dough Animals (if doing you will make the animals this week and paint them the next)
Flour, salt, water, cooking oil, baking sheet, pam spray(optional), cutting boards, rolling pin, plastic knives, and paper cups (will need oven to take home animals and bake them- see recipe)
- Story book or pictures of Noah and the Flood to show kids if available and/or
Flannel Display Board or animal teddy bears with ark with Noah and the Flood Characters, etc. *See Coordinator to see if these types of materials are available at your church.
- Play dough – to share if not doing salt dough activity
- Teddy bear to pass around during “Hot Potato Animal Game”

Snack:

- Fruit Loops Cereal or Skittles candies - enough to share
- Napkins
- Cups with water or milk
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

Week 9:

- Glue to share
- Scissors to share
- God Helps Noah Color Page – one per child
- Animal Stickers for God Helps Noah Color Page – one set per child – 4 sets on a page
- We Worship God Because He Keeps His Promise Booklet Template – one per child

Optional Activities

- Noah and the Ark Rainbow Color Page – one per child – two printed on a page
- God Cares For Me When...Spinning Wheel Template – one per child
- Brad or Paper Fastener – one per child
- Story book or pictures of Noah and the Flood to show kids if available and/or
Flannel Display Board or animal teddy bears with ark with Noah and the Flood Characters, etc. *See Coordinator to see if these types of materials are available at your church.
- Teddy bear to pass around during “Hot Potato Animal Game”
- Fruit Loops Rainbow Craft
- Fruit Loops Cereal – one box *IF a student in class is allergic to wheat you can bring dried or fresh bite sized fruit for them in various colors – grapes, bananas, etc to make the same craft.
- Icing – premade from store – one small container
- Paper plates (to put icing on and to put fruit loops on) – one per child
- Paper plates (to put parchment paper on for finished craft) – one per child
- Parchment paper – one sheet approximately 12 by 12 inches big – one per child
- Tablespoon to hand out icing
- Wet Wipes or Wet Paper Towels to clean hands

*Optional is to just have students make a rainbow out of cereal on a paper plate and then supply a zip-to-close bag to stick their rainbow fruit loops in at the end of class – then there is no need to have icing or extra supplies.

- Salt Dough Animals (if did in previous lesson) as well as:
 - Sharpie marker – to share
 - Washable Paints – various colors to share (colors for animals)
 - Small/Fine Paintbrushes – one per child

- Small containers to put paint in
- Wet wipes or wet towels to wash student's hands when done and clean up
- Smocks or old large t-shirts that students can wear to keep from getting clothes dirty

Snack:

- Fruit Loops Cereal or Skittles candies - enough to share
- Napkins
- Cups with water or milk
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

Week 10:

- Tape to share
- Scissors to share
- Mother's Day Flower Craft Template – one template per child, two on a page cut out before class – print on colored paper or white if you are going to let students color first.
- Chenille or Pipe Cleaner Sticks – one per child
- Mother's Day Card Page – one per child

Optional Activities

- God Made Mothers Color Page – one per child
- Dolls that represent family – dad, mom, sisters, brothers, baby, etc. and/or books that show children about families and especially mothers.
- I'm Glad God thought of Mothers" Book (see CD for scanned images) or borrow from library – A Happy Day Book by Dot Cachiaras

Week 11:

- Tape to share
- Scissors to share
- God Made Fathers – Noah and Sons Color Page – one per child
- Thank you God for Fathers Color Page – one per child

Optional Activities

- Dolls that represent family – dad, mom, sisters, brothers, baby, etc. and/or books that show children about families and especially dads.
- Puppet to help tell story of Noah
- Teddy bear animal for hot potato game
- Play Dough – enough to share for making Noah and his family
- Paper dolls left over from previous lessons for children to play with and decorate
- Noah and the Ark teddy bears, animals, people, etc. so children can pretend

Snack: Your choice - enough to share

- Napkins
- Cups with water or milk

Week 12:

- Scissors to share
- God Gave Us Families and Church Families Maze Sheet – one per child
- God Made Our Families Doll Templates – 2 dolls on a page - give one doll for each member of the child's family – if three family members give three sex appropriate dolls) - print on white cardstock paper

Optional Activities

- Dolls that represent family – dad, mom, sisters, brothers, baby, etc. and/or books that show children about families and especially dads.
- Puppet to help tell story of Noah
- Teddy bear animal for hot potato game
- Play Dough – enough to share for making Noah and his family
- Sidewalk chalk – if wanting to go outside and let children draw their families

Yarn, ribbon, textured fabrics if wanting to put hair and clothes on paper dolls

Week 13:

- Count the Hearts Activity Sheet – one per child
- God loves my family drawing sheet – one per child

Optional Activities

- God is Love Heart Sheet – two per page – one per child – cut page in half before class
- God loves my family color page – one per child
- Dolls that represent family – dad, mom, sisters, brothers, baby, etc. and/or books that show children about families and especially dads.
- Puppet to help tell Bible verse about love
- Soft Ball for hot potato game
- Play Dough – enough to share for making things that God loves
- Sidewalk chalk – if wanting to go outside and let children draw their families
- Glue to share
- Scissors to share
- Basket with things that show what God loves: examples dolls to show God loves people, teddy bears or animals to show that God loves animals, things from nature to show that God created and loves nature, etc.

Snack: Candy hearts or Heart shaped cookie cutter cheese and bread slices.

- Cheese heart shapes one per child
- Bread heart shapes two per child
- Heart Shaped Candies 5 per child
- Napkins for snack one per child
- Juice or water and cup one per child
