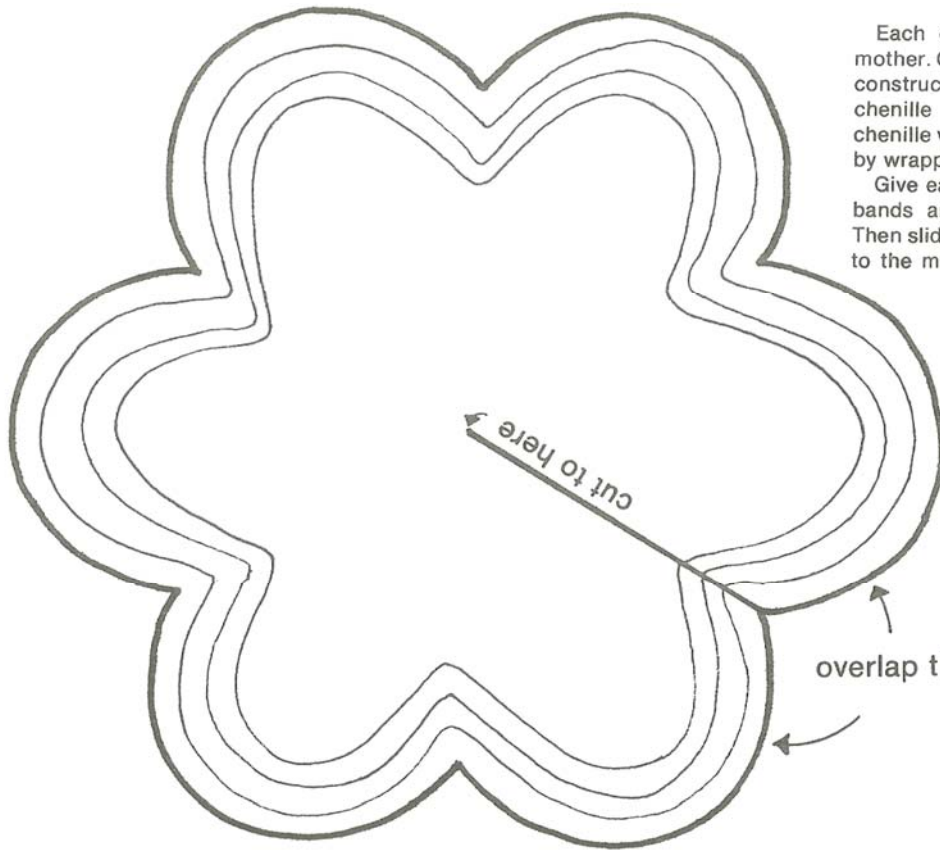


Mother's Day Flower Craft – Two Flowers Per Page

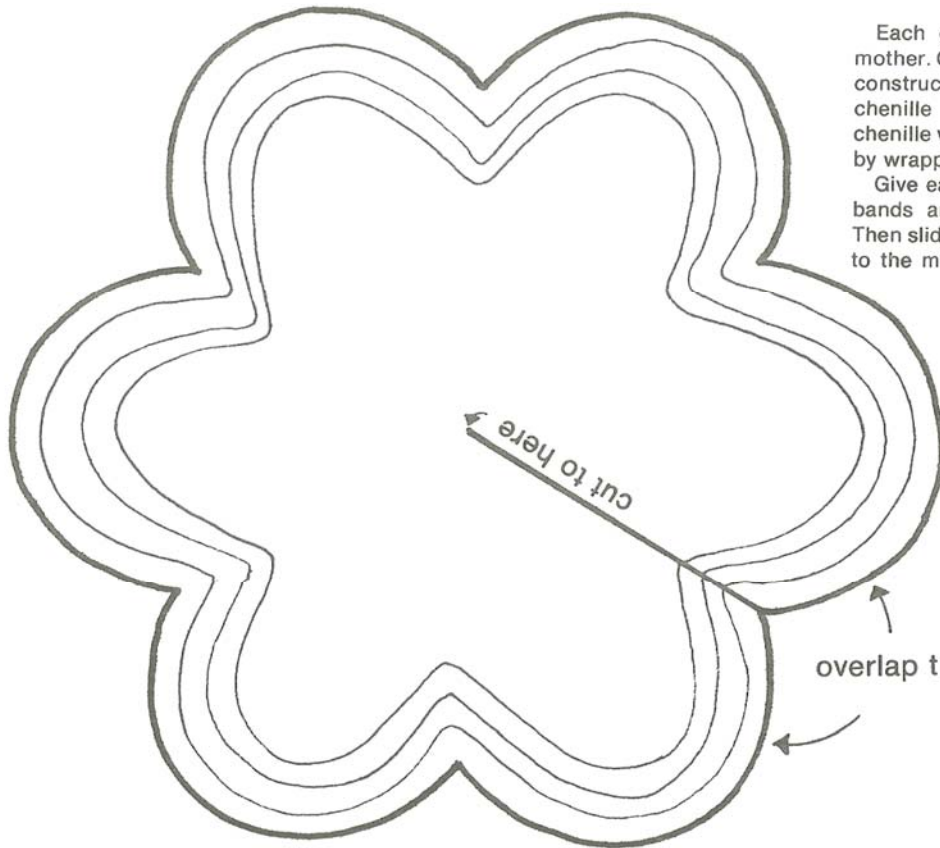


Each child will make a flower for his mother. Cut one pattern out of light-colored construction paper for each child. Have one chenille wire for each child. Fold the chenille wire in half and curl the loose ends by wrapping them around a thin pencil.

Give each child a flower. Let them color bands around the edges using crayons. Then slide the chenille wire through the slit to the middle of the flower. Next, overlap

the petals on either side of the slit. Tape or glue the flower together.

Tell the children to thank their mothers for being patient when they give them the flower.



Each child will make a flower for his mother. Cut one pattern out of light-colored construction paper for each child. Have one chenille wire for each child. Fold the chenille wire in half and curl the loose ends by wrapping them around a thin pencil.

Give each child a flower. Let them color bands around the edges using crayons. Then slide the chenille wire through the slit to the middle of the flower. Next, overlap

Tell the children to thank their mothers for being patient when they give them the flower.
