Everyone agrees to play a game; they decide that if you get hit by a ball you are out of the game. You get hit by a ball but say you did not. Is that fair? What should you do? **Move back 2**



The teacher hands out prizes for the top marks. You did very well and deserve a prize but he forgets to give you one. What is something positive you can do to resolve this, what is something negative you can do? What would you decide to do? **Move 3**



Your classmate tells you that your friend says she doesn't like you anymore. Without asking, you go up to your friend and say, "I never want to speak to you again!" The friend looks stunned. What happened here that wasn't fair? **Move back 3**



Your mom catches you playing on your video games longer than you were supposed to. The rule is only one hour a day and you had played over two hours. She says no video games for a week! Is that fair? Did you deserve to lose your privileges? **Move back 2**



You decide that you are going to do one thing this week to be fairer at home and school. What will it be?
