



How to Play

Print Board Game on White Card Stock. Give the students game pieces (from other games or just coins or candy or whatnot). Place all pieces on start. Have each student roll a die and move forward the number of spaces they roll. If they land on a positive number, they move that many spaces forward too. If they land on a negative number, they move that many spaces back. When they land on a symbol, you ask them a question from the questions below.

Don't penalize the students for wrong answers, just correct the misunderstanding. First one to end wins.

If you have a single child in class, move a piece as well but the child gets to answer all the questions. As you can see, this is primarily a way to review the lesson with the students while they think they are playing.

Before playing Read the story in Genesis of Creation. Genesis 1:1-2:3

Supplies: Board Game Game Pieces Dice Questions

Questions – You may want to switch order depending on age of child the question is being given to.

1. **How did God create light?** Genesis 1:3.

God spoke and the light came to be.

2. **What did God call the light and the darkness on the first day?** Genesis 1:4-5.

God called the light day and the darkness night.

3. **On what day did God create plants and trees?** Genesis 1:11-13.

The third day.

4. **What did God create to govern the day and the night?** Genesis 1:16.

The greater light governs the day and the lesser light governs the night.

5. **What was God's command to the living things in the sea and the birds?** Genesis 1:22.

Be fruitful and increase in number and fill the water in the seas, and let the birds increase on the earth.

6. **What did God do to the living things in the sea and the birds after He created them?** Genesis 1:22.

God blessed them.

7. **What did God use to create livestock?** Genesis 1:24.

God used his voice to create livestock.

8. What did God see after He created the livestock? Genesis 1:24-25.

God saw that they were good.

9. Who did God create in the image of God? Genesis 1:27.

Mankind.

10. What did God do to the man and the woman after He created them? Genesis 1:28.

God blessed them.

11. Name one command God gave to the man and woman after He created them? Genesis 1:28.

Be fruitful and increase in number.

Fill the earth and subdue it.

Rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air and over every living creature that moves on the ground.

12. Name one thing in Genesis 1 that proves that mankind is special to God. Genesis 1:27.

God created mankind in His own image.

13. Name one thing in Genesis 1 that proves that God provides for the needs of His creation. Genesis 1:29-30.

God gave plants for food to mankind, and to all the beasts of the earth, and all the birds of the air, and all the creatures that move on the ground.

14. What did God see after He finished creating everything? Genesis 1:31.

God saw all that he had made and it was very good.

15. What did God do on the seventh day after He finished His creation activities? Genesis 2:2.

He rested.

For younger children you can ask these instead if the above questions are too difficult. For example:

- A. Name an animal God created?
- B. What sound does a cow make? Who created the cow?
- C. What is a bird that God created?
- D. What sound does a duck make? Who created the duck?
