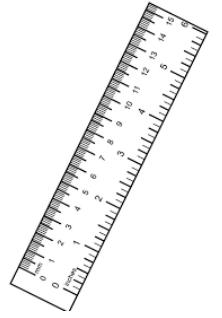


Don't Break the Rules
