Song Sheet for Fall Quarter

Week 1:

- Zip-to-close bag or paper lunch bag – one per student
- Marker to write name of student on bag – one to share
- Tape to share
- Songs for Fall Quarter – printed out one set for class
- Bible Book Cover Template – one per student printed on light colored construction paper and cut out according to directions before class
- Pictures for Bible Book – cut out before class – one set per student
- Stapler – to share or if unavailable, tape to put Bible book together
- Stickers, scrap colored paper, sequins, or ribbon to decorate Bibles
- Glue sticks to share
- I Can Worship God Take Home Chart – one per student

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Bible and Church Activity Game Templates – one set per class to share
- Tape to put up Activity Game Templates
- Dolls of family – enough for each child to get some to play with
- Bibles – one per child (either make paper Bibles using Bible Book Cover Template, or gather real - Bibles enough for each child to look through one)
- Ball – one per class to share

Snack – Bible Book shaped snack such as rectangle shaped cheese or crackers –
enough so each child gets some along with a napkin and a glass of water

Week 2:

- Tape to share
- Bible Book Cover Template – one per student printed on light colored construction paper and cut out according to directions before class
- God Sees Us Bible Pictures – cut out before class – one set per student
- God Sees Us Stickers – cut out before class – 7 sets on a page – one set per student
- Stapler – to share or if unavailable, tape to put Bible book together
- Glue sticks to share
- I Will Obey Feet Template - one template for class to share

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Who We Obey Poster Window – print one set for class (assemble before class)
- Construction paper – 6 sheets to make poster window (see directions below for assembly)
- Scissors to Cut Poster Window – one pair to use before class
- Tape/Glue to put Poster Window together and for Activity Game – one to use before class
- Bible and Church Activity Game Templates – one set for class (can use from previous lesson)
- Dolls of family members – enough for each child to get some to play with
- Scrap paper, ribbon, buttons, stickers or decorations to use on their Bible Cover – to share
- Bibles – one per child (either make paper Bibles using Bible Book Cover Template, or gather real Bibles enough for each child to look through one – keep as each week you will do this activity)

Snack – Bible Book shaped snack such as rectangle shaped cheese or crackers –
enough so each child gets some along with a napkin and a glass of water

Week 3:

- Tape to share
- The Bible Teaches Us to Worship Book – printed and cut before class – one for class to share
*Keep as you will use this in the coming weeks as well
- Turtle Template – printed on white construction or cardstock paper – 2 turtles on a page – 1 turtle per student

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- The Bible Teaches Us to Worship Color Page – one per student
- We Will Obey Activity Game Templates – one set for class
- Tape to put up Activity Game Templates
- Green construction pieces or tissue paper – enough for class to share if wanting to decorate turtle
- Dolls of family members – enough for each child to get some to play with
- Bibles – one per child (either make paper Bibles using Bible Book Cover Template from lesson 2, or gather real Bibles enough for each child to look through one. Keep for each week as you will do this activity often)
- Soft Ball – one for class to share

Snack – Coin shaped snack such as round cookie or orange slices –
enough so each child gets some along with a napkin and a glass of water

Week 4:

- Tape to share
- Church Template – one per student printed on white construction or cardstock paper
- Tree Template – one tree per student printed on construction/cardstock – 2 trees on a page
- Scissors – to cut out templates before class
- Glue and/or Tape to share
- Paper plate – one per student
- Go to Church Maze – one per student
- Book – The Bible teaches us To Worship (the one you made from last week)

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- The Bible Teaches Us to Go to Church Color Page – one per student
- Fall leaves to decorate church building craft – enough for each child to get some (if wanting to decorate “church building” craft with leaves)
- Dolls of family members – enough for each child to get some to play with
- Bibles – one per child (either make paper Bibles using Bible Book Cover Template from lesson 2, or gather real Bibles enough for each child to look through one. Keep for each week as you will do this activity often)

Snack –Bible shaped snack such as fig newtons and icing (see instruction below)
enough so each child gets some along with a napkin and a glass of water



Week 5:

- Tape to share
- Folding Book Template – one template for every two students
- Folding Book Stickers – one set per student 2 sets are on a page (cut out before class)
- Cotton Balls – 1-4 per student
- Glue to share
*Make one I Will Sing Like David Flip Book using the above materials before class (see directions below)
- Take Home Song Sheet – one per student to take home at end of class
- Book – The Bible teaches us To Worship (the one you made from previous lessons)

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Sheep – teddy bear, plastic or cut out pictures of sheep – one per student *or you can make a sheep using template and an empty spool from thread and glue the template to the spool – see directions below.

- Shepherd – teddy bear, plastic doll or cut out pictures – one per student
 - Empty spool from thread – one per student
 - Sheep template – one per student (there are 4 on a page) print onto white cardstock or construction paper before class and cut out.
 - Glue and/or tape to share
 - Cotton balls – 8 or 10 per student
 - Bibles – one per child
- Snack – Celery sticks or something similar to look like “grass” enough for each child along with a napkin and a glass of water

Week 6:

- Tape to share
- Prayer Clock Template with Stickers – printed on white cardstock or construction paper one page per student and cut out before class
- Paper Fastener (Brads) – one per student
- Glue to share
- Stop and Pray Sign – printed on white construction or cardstock paper and cut out before class – one per class for the teacher and/or one for each student to hold during story time and for game
- Popsicle stick(s) – one for each Stop and Pray sign you make
- Tape to attach Stop and Pray Sign to Popsicle stick
- Book – The Bible teaches us To Worship (the one you made from previous lessons)

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- “Thank You Bag” - one plastic or paper bag
 - Thank You Bag pictures – print and cut out before class or gather small plastic doll, toy, food and bed or blanket to stick in bag to do thank you bag activity (see below)
 - Time to Pray Match Activity Sheet – one per student
 - Glue to share
 - Scissors to share (for those too young to cut – precut the squares on the Time to Pray Sheet)
 - Daniel Prayed Color Page – one set per student – 2 sets on a page. Cut page in half before class
 - Dolls of family members – enough for each child to get some to play with
 - Church building template – the one from last time pre-made so children’s doll families have a place to go for worship
 - Bibles – one per child
 - Books or Visual Aids on Prayer – example: I Can Pray - A Happy Day Book
- Snack – Piece of bread or something that can be folded – to remind students of folding hands in Prayer. Enough for each child along with a napkin and a glass of water

Week 7:

- Tape to share
- Collecting Money Plate Craft Template – one sheet per student printed on white construction or cardstock paper
- Scissors – to cut out plates before class
- Tape to share
- I Can Give Drawing Sheet – one per student
- Book – The Bible teaches us To Worship (the one you made from previous lessons)

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Widow’s Offering Book – By Arch Books (if available)
- Coin for each child to put in collection plate – make sure each child gets the same value in coin also have coins for demonstration along with a bucket or bowl that will make a noise when coins are dropped into the bowl/bucket
- I Can Give Color Page – one per student
- Aluminum Foil – small round pieces for each child to tape or glue to color page
- Tape or Glue – to share
- Dolls of family members – enough for each child to get some to play with

- Church building template – the one from last time pre-made so children’s doll families have a place to go for worship
 - Bibles – one per child
 - Play Dough – enough so each child can play with some dough and make coins and a plate
 - Books or Visual Aids on Giving
 - Soft Ball – Roll the Ball Game to learn how to share/give the ball – one per class to share
- Snack – Coin shaped snack – to remind students of giving enough for each child to get some
Napkin and a glass of water

Week 8:

- Tape to share
- I Can Worship Mobile Template – one per student printed and cut out before class
- Paper plates – ½ for each child, cut before class
- Hole Puncher or Tape – to share
- String – 5 pieces of different length for each child
- Glue sticks – enough to share
- Book – The Bible teaches us To Worship (the one you made from previous lessons)

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- I Spy and Activity Game Page – one per class printed and cut out before class
 - Tape to hang “I spy” pictures around room and to play activity game
 - I Can Listen Color page – one per student
 - Dolls of family members – enough for each child to get some to play with
 - Church building template – the one from last time pre-made so children’s doll families have a place to go for worship
 - Bibles – one per child
- Snack – Your choice - enough for each child along with a napkin and a glass of water

Week 9:

- Tape to share
- I Will Follow Jesus Color Page – one per student
- Fall leaves – enough for each child to get 5-7 dried leaves
- Blank piece of paper – one per child
- I Will Follow Jesus Sheep Stickers Page – one per child there are 18 on a page
- Book – The Bible teaches us To Worship (the one you made from previous lessons)

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Sheep – teddy bear, plastic or cut out pictures of sheep – one per student *or you can make a sheep using template and an empty spool from thread and glue the template to the spool – see directions below or use the sheep you made from lesson 5 if you did
- Shepherd – plastic doll or cut out pictures – one per student
- Empty spool from thread – one per student
- Sheep template – one per student (there are 4 on a page) print onto white cardstock or construction paper before class and cut out.
- Glue and/or tape to share
- Cotton balls – 8 or 10 per student
- Bibles – one per child

Week 10:

- Tape to share
- I Will Follow Jesus Leaf Template – one per student cut out before class for those too young to cut
- Scissors – to share
- Hole Punch – to share
- String – one 12 inch piece per student
- Cinnamon in a small spice shaker jar – one for class to share (optional)
- The Church’s Building Puzzle – one per student printed and cut out before class
- Glue sticks to share
- Book – The Bible teaches us To Worship (the one you made from previous lessons)

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Worship Memory Match Sheet (match pictures to each other) (print 1 set for every two students on white cardstock or construction paper and cut out before class)
- Dolls of family members – enough for each child to get some to play with
- Church building template – the one from last time pre-made so children’s doll families have a place to go for worship
- Bibles – one per child

Snack – Different shaped cheese, crackers, or fruit - enough for each child along with a napkin and a glass of water

Week 11:

- Tape to share
- I Will Follow Jesus and Obey Color and Trace Sheet – one per student
- I Will Obey Banner – one per student printed preferably on construction or cardstock paper and cut out before class for those too young to cut with scissors themselves

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- I Will Obey Feet Template - one template for class to share
- Whom Do We Obey Poster – one made from lesson 2
- “I’m Glad I’m Your Dad” Book (see attached for scanned images) or borrow from library – A Happy Day Book by Bill and Kathy Horlacher
- “I’m Glad God Thought of Mothers” Book (see attached for scanned images) or borrow from library – A Happy Day Book by Dot Cachiaras
- Dolls of family members – enough for each child to get some to play with
- Church building template – the one from last time pre-made so children’s doll families have a place to go for worship
- Bibles – one per child

Snack – Your choice - enough for each child along with a napkin and a glass of water

Week 12:

- Scissors to share (for those old enough to cut, or cut picture frames out in advance yourself)
- Jesus Loves Me Picture Frame – one per student printed on cardstock or construction paper
- String – one per student about 12 inches long
- Jesus Loves Me Maze and Draw – one per student

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Buttons, sequins, scrap paper, ribbon pieces, etc. to decorate picture frame – enough to share
- Glue sticks to share
- I Will Obey Feet Template - one template for class to share
- Jesus Loves Me Color Page - one per student
- Play Dough – enough so each child gets some to play with
- Heart Shaped Cookie Cutters – to share (if wanting to use with play dough)
- Bibles – one per child



- Soft Ball – one per class to share
- Snack – Heart shaped strawberries - enough for each child along with a napkin and a glass of water

Week 13:

- Tape to share
- I Can Worship God Take Home Chart – one per student
- Necklace Bible Template – printed on white construction or cardstock paper and cut out – one per student, there are 12 Bibles on a page.
- Scissors to share
- Yarn or soft string – one piece per student long enough to tie loosely around neck with a bow
- Hole Punch – to share
- Church puzzle picture – one set per student, there are two sets on a page – cut out before class for those too young to cut safely/appropriately
- Paper clips – a few to keep the puzzle shapes separated to make craft go easier
- Blank sheet of paper – one per child (big enough to put church puzzle on)
- Glue sticks to share

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Bible and Church Activity Game Templates – one set per class to share
 - The Bible is God's Word Maze – one per student
 - Tape to put up Activity Game Templates
 - Dolls of family – enough for each child to get some to play with
 - Bibles – one per child (either make paper Bibles using Bible Book Cover Template, or gather real Bibles enough for each child to look through one)
 - Ball – one per class to share
