#### Week 4:

- Fruit of My Lips Being Thankful Drawing Sheet (one per child)
- Chalkboard or Easel to write down ideas for all to see
- Color page: Daniel is thankful (one per child)

#### Optional

- Ball (being thankful; pass the ball game) – one for class to share
- Snack: Fruit of our lips.
  - Fruit slices (Strawberries, bananas, pears, etc.) 5 per child
  - Napkins for snack one per child
  - Juice or water and cup one per child

#### Week 5:

- God is Faithful Banner Paper (11 x 17 Computer copy paper or large construction paper in light color so kids can color over) - one per child
- Construction Paper in Rainbow Colors – so children can take strips to make rainbow
- Glue Sticks
- Scissors
- Paper Bag

#### Teacher Gift Craft
