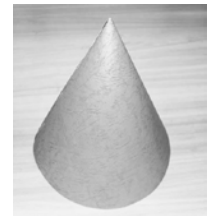

Week 1:

- Masking Tape – 10 foot strip for class
- Construction Paper Cone “Pylon” that marks the end – one for class
- Tape – enough to put cone together
- Black Marker – to share
- Large sheet of paper for class to share
- Focus on Jesus Maze and Take Home Sheet – one per student
- I Will Checklist – one per student



Optional:

- Following Jesus Board Game – one per two students
- Coin to flip – one per two students
- Buttons – one per student as marker for game

- Lesson Review Visual Aids – one for teacher to share at the beginning of each class
- Put God First Activity Sheets – one set per student
- Large Easel or Piece of Paper – one for class to share
- Marker – to share



Optional:

Masking Tape – for teacher

Week 3:

- Lesson Review Visual Aids – one for teacher to share at the beginning of each class
- Pieces of paper – one per student
- 2 large sheets of paper taped to wall or easel – one for teacher
- Marker – for teacher
- Jesus is the Way Crack the Code – one per student

Optional:

- I Can Pray! (Happy Day Book) – Purchase online if available – one per class to read
- Pieces of paper – one per student to draw on
- Any Time Any Place Spin Game – print one per student to take home (there are 2 on a page)

- Scissors to cut out spin game – enough to share if cutting out before taking game home
- Paperclip – one per student
- *Small pencil – either give one per student or let them use pencils from home for take home game

Snack:

- Heart-shaped Fruit (like strawberries) a few for each student
- Napkins one per student
- Water/Cup one per student



Week 4:

- Lesson Review Visual Aids – one for teacher to share at the beginning of each class
- 1 large sheet of paper taped to wall or an easel – one for teacher
- Marker – for teacher

Thumbbody Loves You Cards

- Construction paper (light colors or white) – one sheet per student
- Wet Paper Towels – enough to wipe up any spills and for students to wipe hands
- Washable Ink Pads or Paint – enough for students to share and make thumbprints on paper.
- If using paint – small plastic lid or bowl to put a small amount of washable paint in – 1 per 4 students

Ripple Effect Demonstration

- Small clear bowl to put a small amount of water at the bottom in – one for class to see
- Dropper – if available – one for teacher to demonstrate
- Small amount of water in a sealable container – to pour into clear bowl, to wet paper towel and to use

to fill dropper or to dip finger in to do demonstration.

Optional:

- Love Everyone Activity Sheet – one set per student

Snack:

- Heart-shaped Fruit (like strawberries) a few for each student
- Napkins one per student
- Water/Cup one per student



Week 5:

- Lesson Review Visual Aids – one for teacher to share at the beginning of each class
- The Bible Story of the Book of Esther – one copy for teacher to read from
- Esther Visual Aids – one copy for class to share
- Be Responsible Activity Sheet – one per student (The back side will be used for drawing activity)

Optional:

- Just in Time Esther (Arch Books) – purchase online or get from library if available
- Small Pieces of Paper with different chores/responsible situations listed – one per student
- Cup/Container – one to put strips of paper inside

Snack:

- No Snack to show importance of fasting
- Water/Cup one per student

Week 6:

- Lesson Review Visual Aids – one for teacher to share at the beginning of each class from lesson 2
- Rooftop Friends Visual Aids – one copy for class to share
- Large sheet of paper (either 11 x 14” or poster board) – one for teacher and for every 2-3 students
- Marker – one for teacher
- Scissors – one for teacher
- Tape or Fun Tac – enough to put paper on wall or board

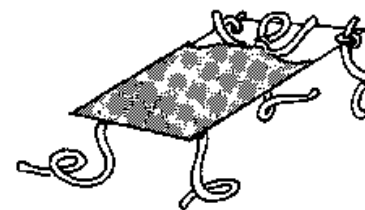
Optional:

- Four Faithful Friends (Happy Day Books) – purchase online or get from library if available

Man on Mat Craft

- 4x6 File Card (or construction paper cut to size) – one per student

- Hole punch – one or two to share
- Yarn/String – 4 x 9 inch pieces per student
- Chenille Wire – 1 and ¼ piece per student
- Glue sticks – to share
- Scissors – to share
- Flannel/Fabric – one 4x6 inch piece per student



Snack:

- Graham Crackers (to represent mat) a few per student
- Napkin one per student
- Water/Cup one per student

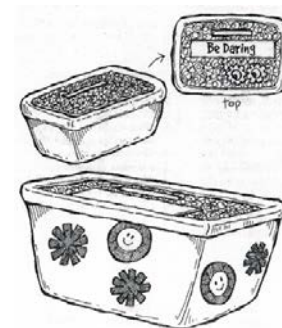
Week 7:

- Lesson Review Visual Aids – one for teacher to share at the beginning of each class from lesson 2
- Widow’s Coins Visual Aids – one copy for class to share
- Sharing Activity Sheet – one per student
- 20 Index or File Cards 4 x 6 inches (or if needed cut out cards from cardstock paper) – one set for every 4 students
- Marker – one for teacher

Optional:

Coin Bank Craft

- Recycled or purchased square plastic small containers (ex: from baby food, dollar store, hummus, etc.) – one per student with labels removed, cleaned and dried)
- Sharpie Markers – to share
- Stickers – smiley faces, dots, hearts, flowers, etc – to share
- Wiggly Eyes – 2 per student (optional)
- Glue Sticks – to share
- Scrap Construction or Felt Paper to cut and cover lid and to decorate sides – to share
- Scissors – to share
- Be Daring Phrase Sheet – before class cut out one per student on cardstock or construction paper
- Coins – if desired, hand out two real coins to each student to put into their coin bank to get them started. Ensure each student gets the same amount of money.



Snack:

- Banana, Kiwi, or Orange Slices (to represent coins) a few per student
- Napkin one per student
- Water/Cup one per student

Week 8:

- Lesson Review Visual Aids – one for teacher to share at the beginning of each class from lesson 2
- Samuel Visual Aids – one copy for class to share
- Samuel Listens Activity Sheet – one per student
- I am Ready Poster Sheet – one per student

Optional:

- Sticky Note Package – one small package of sticky notes for each student to do refrigerator home activity with family. (Mentioned on activity sheet).
- Index cards or pieces of paper – one per student
- Paper bag – one for teacher to put paper/cards into

Snack:

- Banana slices (a “silent” food so they can listen) a few per student
- Napkin one per student
- Water/Cup one per student

Week 9:

- Lesson Review Visual Aids – one for teacher to share at the beginning of each class from lesson 2
- Daniel Chapter 3 Visual Aids – one copy for class to share
- I Will Stand Up Activity Sheet – one per student

Optional:

- Faith and Standing Strong Songs – two on a page, one set per student cut out before class
- Scrap paper pieces (small) – 8; 4 for each team

Snack:

- Red, Yellow, Orange Pepper Slices (to represent fiery furnace) a few per student
- Napkin one per student
- Water/Cup one per student

Week 10:

- Lesson Review Visual Aids – one for teacher to share at the beginning of each class from lesson 2
- Miriam Visual Aids – one copy for class to share
- I Will Be Wise Activity Sheet – one per student

Optional:

- Who Am I Pictures – one set for class cut out before hand
- Tape – to share
- Scrap paper pieces (small) – 8; 4 for each team

Snack:

- Cupcake Holders (Basket) 1 or 2 per student
- Bananas (Baby Moses) Cut in fourths – one for each holder
- Poppy Seeds or Chocolate Chips (Eyes) 2 for each banana baby Moses
- Fruit Roll Up, Cheese Slice, or Cucumber Slice (cut as blanket) 1 piece cut to size to cover Moses
- Napkin one per student
- Water/Cup one per student

Week 11:

- Lesson Review Visual Aids – one for teacher to share at the beginning of each class from lesson 2
- Elijah Color Page/Visual Aids – one per student
- Elijah Activity Sheet – one per student
- Waiting for Something Great Story – one per student if reading as a group

Optional:

- Be Patient Craft Sheet – one per student
- Black Construction Paper – one per student
- Tape – to share
- Thumbtack/Push Pin – one per student
- Cardboard pieces – one per student to protect table from pins poking it
- Paper cups – 50 per every 3-4 students

Snack: Fed by Birds Skewers

- Fruit, cheese cubes, or bread pieces a few for each student
- Bird Templates – one set of birds folded one set for each student
- Tape – to stick bird to toothpick as needed
- Toothpicks one per student
- Napkin one per student
- Water/Cup one per student



Week 12:

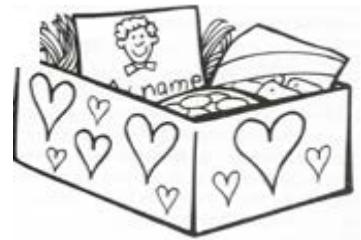
- Lesson Review Visual Aids – one for teacher to share at the beginning of each class from lesson 2
- Benefits of Encouragement Story – one per student if reading as a group
- Scissors – to share
- Encouraging Notes – one sheet per student

Optional: Cheer Packages

*Prepare in advance who you would give these packages too, a children's ward, senior's center, hospital, etc. Then if desired, plan a time with parents to have students meet as a group and hand out packages to the people in the place you chose and arrange with the directors there to maybe have kids sing some church songs with their parents to encourage the people.

- Clean shoe box or similar box – one per student
- Candies or chocolates (individually wrapped or in small sealed bags) – one bag per student
- Small store bought boxes or bags of raisins, crackers, cookies – 1-3 packages per student
- Different Colored Construction Paper – enough for class to share to cover their boxes
- Stickers – encouraging stickers such as hearts– enough for each student to put some on box
- Scrap Colored Paper – enough for children to cut out heart shapes
- Glue sticks – to share
- Scissors – to share
- Tissue Paper or Easter Grass – enough for each child to fill the bottom of their box
- Paper cut to card size – for each student to draw something nice on it
- *IF giving packages to people in a hospital type setting you can also include small

packages of Kleenex, hand lotion, notepad and pens, etc.



Grab Bag Words Game

- Grab Bag Words – one sheet for teacher to cut out before class
- Paper Bag – one for teacher to put Grab Bag Words into

Snack: Mints or Raisins

- Mints and/or Raisins a few for each student
- Napkin one per student
- Water/Cup one per student

Week 13:

- Lesson Review Visual Aids – one for teacher to share at the beginning of each class from lesson 2
- Stand Up for God Story – one per student if reading as a group
- What Would You Do Situation Sheet – one per student
- We Will Honor God Activity Sheet – one per student
- We Will Honor God Answer Key – one for teacher

Optional:

Grab Bag Words Game

- Grab Bag Words – one sheet for teacher to cut out before class from previous lesson
- Paper Bag – one for teacher to put Grab Bag Words into from previous lesson

- Snack enough for each student
- Napkin one per student
