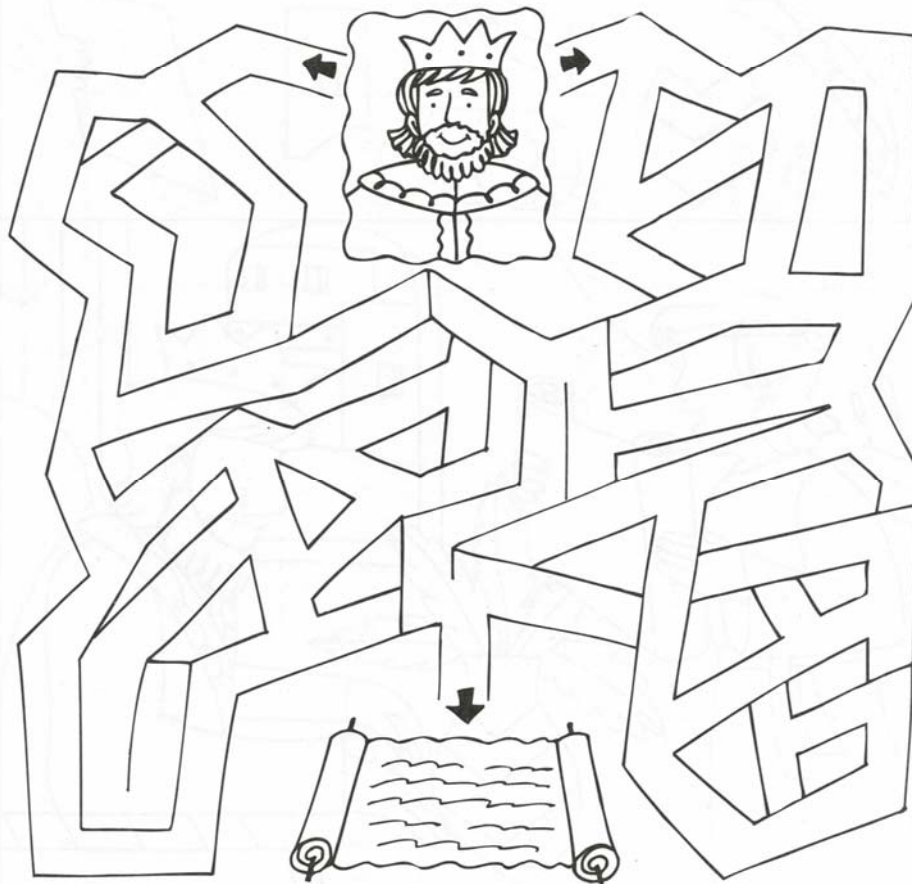


# King Josiah
