Make sure teacher has the following supplies every week plus the ones specific for the week they are teaching.

### **Week 1:**

- Pictures about Fishing – one sheet for class cut out before class
- Jesus Helps Catch Fish Activity Sheet – one per student
- Jesus Helps Catch Fish Color Page (or visual aid) – one per student
- Draw Fish Activity Sheet – one per student

#### **Optional Activities**

- Bubble blowers and bubble jars – purchase these at store – enough to share
- Fish Stickers – One sheet per class cut out before class – see template provided
- Glue sticks to share
- Fish crackers – one box for class to share
- Paper cups – one per student
- Large grocery bag – one per class to share
- Magnetic fish poles with fish – purchase at toy section of store – one per student
- Snack – fish shaped crackers or cheese
- Napkins
- Cups with water
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

### **Week 2:**

- Pictures about Storms – one sheet for class cut out before class
- Jesus Stops the Storm Visual Aid Pictures – one for class to share
- Jesus Stops the Storm Activity Sheet – one per student
- Jesus Stops the Storm Wave Activity Sheet – one per student
- Brads or paper fasteners – 3 per student
- Scissors to share

#### **Optional Activities**

- Jesus Calms the Storm – Arch Books – purchase online <http://www.amazon.com/Jesus-Calms-Storm-Arch-Books/dp/0758606370> or borrow from library
- Jesus Stops the Storm Craft Pages – one set per student cut out before class
- Brads or paper fasteners – 1 per student
- Blue sheet or blue plastic or cloth table cover – one for class
- Balloon inflated or soft, light ball – one per class to share
- Plastic bottle with lid – empty, cleaned and label removed filled 2/3 with water
- Salt (1 tsp)
- Dishwashing liquid – one drop
- Blue Food Coloring – 2 drops (if unavailable you can still do the activity the water will just be clear instead of blue)
- White Glue – one to share
- Snack – fish shaped crackers or cheese
- Napkins
- Cups with water
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

### Week 3:

- Jesus Helps Circle Story Template – one set per student cut out before class
- Brads or paper fasteners – 1 per student
- Jesus Helps – Bird Activity Sheet – 1 per student
- Jesus Helps Bird Stickers – 1 sheet has 27 stickers, 1 per student cut out before class
- Small piece of yarn – one per student
- Tape to share
- Glue sticks to share
- Jesus Helps Man Visual Aid – one per class to share
- We Can Tell Others Too Smiley Face Sheet – one per student
- Smiley Face Stickers – 4 per student there are 63 on a sheet – cut out before class
- Scissors to share

#### Optional Activities

- Jesus Heals Color Code Sheet – one per student
- Blindfold Template – 2 on a sheet – one per student cut out before class
- Elastic string or rubber band – one per student cut to about 8 to 12 inches in length enough to be attached to blind fold and go around students head
- Stapler to share
- Toy dishes, toys, teddy bears, dolls, things for the students to try and figure out what they are while they are blindfolded
- Play dough – enough for each student to get some
- Snack – chocolate pudding cups with plastic spoons (to represent clay)
- Napkins
- Cups with water
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

### Week 4:

- Jesus Helps Man Walk Visual Aid – one per class to share
- Man Who is Lame Doll Template – one per student – 4 on a page cut out before class
- 4 x 10 inch brown paper rectangle – one per student for man's mat
- Green construction paper folded in half and cut – one half sheet per student
- Brad or paper fastener – one per student
- Scissors and ruler for teacher to cut sheets
- Marker – one for class to share
- Jesus Helps Me Too Sheet – one per student

#### Optional Activities

- Jesus Helps Man Walk Color Pages 1 and 2 – one set per student
- "Down through the Roof" Arch Book – ordered online <http://www.amazon.com/Down-through-Roof-Arch-Books/dp/0570075629> or borrowed from library
- 4 x 6 inch file card or construction paper – one per student
- 4 x 4 inch felt or flannel cloth – one per student
- White Glue – to share
- Pipe Cleaners or Chenille Wire – 5-6 pieces per student
- Scissors for teacher to cut pipe cleaners/chenille wire and box
- Box with lid – before class draw a door but don't cut it out, draw steps going up the side of the house. Cut a section of the lid to make a hole in the "roof"
- Marker – to draw on box
- Play Dough – enough for each student to get one color
- Snack – Fruit Roll Up or Rectangle shaped crackers – to represent mat
- Napkins
- Cups with water
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

### Week 5:

- Stickers – enough for each child to have one every lesson for 13 lessons
- Pictures about Fishing – one sheet for class cut out before class (Take from lesson 3)
- Pictures about Storms – one sheet for class cut out before class (Take from lesson 2)
- Paper plate – draw happy face on one side and sad face on other side before class
- Jesus is God's Son Drawing Sheet – one per student

#### Optional Activities

- Blue sheet or blue plastic or cloth table cover – one for class (from lesson 2)
- Balloon inflated or soft, light ball – one per class to share (from lesson 2)
- Jesus Calms the Storm – Arch Books – (from lesson 2)
- "Down through the Roof" Arch Book – (from lesson 3)
- Blind folds – (made from lesson 3) – one per student or one to use as visual aid
- Scissors for teacher to cut box if not previously done
- Box with lid – (made from lesson 4) - before class draw a door but don't cut it out, draw steps going up the side of the house. Cut a section of the lid to make a hole in the "roof"
- Fish crackers – one box for class to share
- Paper cups – one per student
- Large grocery bag – one per class to share
- Snack – fish crackers or cheese in fish shape
- Napkins
- Cups with water

### Week 6:

- Jesus Andrew and Peter Page – one per student
- Andrew and Peter People Stickers Template – one per student cut out before class
- Scissors for teacher
- Yarn – one 8 inch piece per student
- Drinking Straw – cut into one inch lengths – one small piece per student
- Tape – to share
- Jesus Calls for Friends Activity Sheets – one set printed back to back or print each and tape back to back before class
- Jesus and His Friends Popsicle Pictures – one set cut out before class
- 4 Popsicle Sticks – to tape onto backs of Popsicle pictures

#### Optional Activities

- Jesus Calls for Friends Visual Aid/Color Page – one per class if visual or one per student
- Unbreakable Mirror – one per class to share
- Blue Tissue Paper or Construction Paper – ripped into small pieces – one sheet to share
- Fish Stickers – one sheet per class cut out before class – see template provided
- Glue sticks to share
- Toy Boats – one per child
- Towels – one or two in case there is a spill
- Small plastic tub
- Water – to fill just the bottom of the tub
- Plastic dolls for boats

OR Big Box with lid or top removed so students can fit inside and pretend they are in a boat or chairs lined up and paired side by side so students can sit as if sitting in a boat.

- Towels to use as "nets" for fishing
- Snack – fish shaped crackers or cheese
- Napkins
- Cups with water
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

### Week 7:

- Jesus and Friends Popsicle Stick People – 3 Sets per page – one set per student
- Popsicle sticks – 3 per child
- Tape – to share
- Jesus Visits Friends Color Page – one per child

#### Optional Activities

- Shoe box or similar- one or more for children to use as a house. Have the box if possible be tall so that dolls can “walk” into it. Draw windows on the inside.
- Mirror – one per class
- Dolls – men and women to show Mary, Martha and Jesus. If possible have visual aids or books that show Jesus and His friends as well
- Marker – to draw on box
- Snack – Your choice
- Napkins
- Cups with water
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

### Week 8:

- Jesus and Zacchaeus Activity Sheet – one per student
- Jesus and Zacchaeus Insert – one per student, 7 on a page cut out before class
- Scissors
- Zacchaeus Activity Sheet with Cut outs – one set per student – cut out before class
- Tape to share
- Glue sticks to share
- Jesus and Zacchaeus Matching Game – printed on cardstock or construction paper - one set per student – cut out before class

#### Optional Activities

- Zacchaeus Visual Aid – one for class to share
- Acorns, Pinecones, Small Tree Branches, Twigs, Leaves, Pictures of Trees – to share
- Paper lunch bag – one to share to place tree items above into.
- Unbreakable Mirror – one to share
- Paper Plate with Marker – draw a happy face on one side and a sad face on the other
- Green Tissue Paper – ripped/cut into small pieces – enough for students to share
- Jesus Makes a Friend - Zacchaeus Color Page – one per student
- Snack – Broccoli pieces to look like trees and cheese (sliced or melted)
- Napkins
- Cups with water
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

### Week 9:

- Jesus is My Friend Booklet – one sheet per student
- Jesus is My Friend Activity Sheet – one per student
- Jesus is My Friend Teddy Bear Sticker – one per student (12 on a page) cut out before class
- Glue sticks to share
- Scissors
- Zacchaeus Visual Aid – one per class (from lesson 8)
- Jesus and His Friends Popsicle Pictures – one set for class (from lesson 6)
- Jesus Visits Popsicle Pictures – one set for class (from lesson 7)

#### Optional Activities

- Unbreakable Mirror – one for class to share
- Jesus is My Friend Circle Craft – one set of sheets per student cut out before class
- Brad or Paper Fastener – one per student
- Tin Foil – one 2 inch x 2 inch piece per student
- Large Paper Plates – one per student (black if possible)

- Cleaning supplies such as small dustpans, brooms, clothes, dusters, empty spray bottles – enough for students to share
- Popcorn in paper cups or paper lunch bags – one cup or bag of popcorn per student
- Wet wipes or paper towels – one per student to clean hands
- Snack – Popcorn in cups or paper lunch bags
- Napkins
- Cups with water
- Puppet to tell students the real events from the Bible

### Week 10:

- Mother's Day Card or Grandmother Card – one per child to choose printed on white cardstock
- Choose one or both of the crafts below:

#### **Decorate Flower Pot with Live Plant**

- Small flowering plant with pot that can be decorated (for one or two dollars) one for each student
- Wax or colored paper – one small piece per student to wrap around the base of flower pot to ensure dirt/water doesn't spill
- Elastic band – one per student to fit over flower pot to hold wax paper in place

OR

- Ribbon – one piece per student to wrap around flower pot and make a bow
- Various stickers that represent Mother's Day ideas – hearts, flowers, thanks, etc. – enough to share
- Sharpie pen – one to share to write on flower pot



#### **Mother's Day Basket Craft**

- Mother's Day Basket Craft Template – printed on white cardstock paper – one per student and cut out before class
- Treats for mom or grandma to go in basket – enough per student ex: candies, pencils, gum, small pad of paper, etc.
- Construction paper or cardstock paper scraps to make a base for gift basket – enough for each child

#### Optional Activities

- Dolls that represent family – dad, mom, sisters, brothers, baby, etc. and/or books that show children about families and especially mothers.
- "I'm Glad God thought of Mothers" Book purchased online or borrow from library – A Happy Day Book by Dot Cachiaras

Snack: Your choice - enough to share

- Napkins
- Cups with water

### Week 11:

- Pictures about Fishing – one sheet for class cut out before class (Take from lesson 3)
- Jesus is Alive Activity Sheet – one per student
- Jesus is Alive Stickers – one set per student – 6 sets on a page cut out before class
- Glue sticks and/or tape – to share
- Scissors – for teacher
- Jesus is God’s Son Mobile Template – one set per student cut out before class
- Construction Paper folded in half – one per student
- Yarn/String – one roll or 5 x 8 inch pieces per student
- Wire or plastic coat hanger – one per student
- Stapler to share
- Hole punch to share

#### Optional Activities

- Play Dough – enough to share
- Fish crackers – one box for class to share
- Paper cups – one per student
- Large grocery bag – one per class to share
- Snack – fish crackers or cheese in fish shape
- Napkins
- Cups with water

### Week 12:

- Pictures of Times to Talk to Jesus
- Nicodemus talks to Jesus Page – one per student
- Talk to Jesus Activity Sheet – one per student
- Scissors to share (or for teacher to use if students are too young to cut on their own)
- Glue sticks to share

#### Optional Activities

- Doll Template – one sheet per student printed on cardstock paper
- Scissors to cut out dolls
- Shoebox – one per student or to share to be a “house”
- J is for Jesus Sheet – one per student
- Action Game Template – one per class cut in half before class
- Tape to put up game template
- Snack people – Children can make Jesus and Nicodemus out of snacks
- Toothpicks – 5 cut in half per student (make sure there are no shards of wood left)
- Celery piece – one per student
- Cheese chunk – one per student (1 x 1 inch cube of cheese)
- Grapes – 10 per student
- Banana slice – one per student (1 inch piece of banana)
- Napkins
- Cups with water
- Puppet to tell story from Bible
