Floppy Keeps Searching

Fred: "Hi Floppy, now what are you looking for?"

Floppy: "Well since you told me about Jesus, I thought I'd see what else I could find!"

Flippy: "You don't need to look for anything else. Jesus is everything you need and you can find Him in all sorts of places – and even more important He can always find you."

Fred: "Yeah, Jesus is everywhere."

Floppy: "How do you know?"

Fred: "Well if you keep reading your Bible, you'll learn all sorts of things about Jesus, and you'll be able to help others who may not know about Jesus too. The Bible is great for helping us know more about Jesus and what He wants for us.

Flippy: "The Bible says that Jesus is everywhere, you can read it in the book of Psalms – that is a book in the Bible."

Floppy: So then I was right, Jesus is in the river too!

Flippy: "Well, wherever you are He is and He can be anywhere at any time."

Fred: "Psalm 139: 7-18 says about looking for Jesus:

Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence? If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there. If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I

settle on the far side of the sea, even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast.

If I say, "Surely the darkness will hide me and the light become night around me," even the darkness will not be dark to you; the night will shine like the day,

for darkness is as light to you. For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb.

I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful,

I know that full well. My frame was not hidden from you when I was made in the secret place.

When I was woven together in the depths of the earth, your eyes saw my unformed body. All the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be.

How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them! Were I to count them, they would outnumber the grains of sand. When I awake, I am still with you.
