

Winter Master List of Supplies: All activity sheets or templates are on website at sundayschoollessonsforkids.com .

Make sure teacher has the following supplies every week plus the ones specific for the week they are teaching.

- Pens/Pencils
- Bible (please bring your own)
- Crayons/Pencil Crayons

Week 1:

- Attendance Chart – one per student printed on construction or cardstock paper
- Thumbtacks – if hanging attendance charts on the wall
- Songs for Winter Quarter – printed out - one set for class
- Scissors – to cut out stickers before class
- Visit From and Angel Sheet – one per student
- Glue sticks to share
- Tape to share
- Paper fastener brads – one per student
- String – 6 inches long – one per student
- Mary and Angel Stickers Sheet – one sticker of Mary and Angel per student, 2 sets on a page
- Happy News from God Sheet- one per student
- Angel Stickers Sheet – one sticker per student, 4 on a page

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Small piece of cloth – one per student as blanket for baby Jesus
- Gold glitter or gold glitter glue plus a box with lid to put extra glitter into as it falls off
- Optional Color Page (or you can use as a visual aid) – one per student
- Letter in an envelope, Toy telephone or old cell phone, Newspaper, and Bible – one per class
- Four pieces of cloth or paper to cover each item above – letter, phone, paper, Bible
- Flashlight – one per class
- Angel and Mary Stickers Template – cut out and printed on cardstock to use as Popsicle stick people – one of each for each student (Keep these in class as you will use them again)
- Popsicle sticks – two per student – one for Mary and one for Angel
- Tape to share – to tape the stick to the cardstock stickers
- Bibles – one per child

Snack – Bible Book shaped snack such as rectangle shaped cheese or crackers – enough so each child gets some along with a napkin and a glass of water

Week 2:

- Joseph Obeys God Color Page – one per student
- Mary and Joseph Paper Towel People Sheet – one sheet per student cut before class
- Empty paper towel cardboard rolls – 5 inches approximately in height x 2 rolls per student
- Tape to share
- Scissors to cut out Mary and Joseph People – cut out figures before class for those too young to cut
- I Will Obey Feet Template - one template for class to share

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Angel and Mary Stick Figure Template – cut out and printed on cardstock to use as Popsicle stick people – one for each student (Keep these in class as you will use them again if you did not already make them from last class)
- Joseph Stick Figure Template - cut out and printed on cardstock to use as Popsicle stick people – one for each student (Keep these in class as you will use them again)
- Popsicle sticks – three per student – one for Mary, Angel, and Joseph Figures
- Tape to share – to tape the stick to the cardstock Popsicle figures
- Bibles – one per child

Snack – Bible Book shaped snack such as rectangle shaped cheese or crackers – enough so each child gets some along with a napkin and a glass of water

Week 3:

- Mary and Joseph Paper Towel People Sheet – one sheet per student cut before class
- Empty paper towel cardboard rolls – 5 inches approximately in height x 2 rolls per student
- Tape to share
- Scissors to cut out Mary and Joseph People – cut out figures before class for those too young to cut
- I Will Obey Feet Template - one template for class to share

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Angel and Mary Stick Figure Template – cut out and printed on cardstock to use as Popsicle stick people – one for each student (Keep these in class as you will use them again if you did not already make them from last class)
- Joseph Stick Figure Template - cut out and printed on cardstock to use as Popsicle stick people – one for each student (Keep these in class as you will use them again)
- Popsicle sticks – three per student – one for Mary, Angel, and Joseph Figures
- Tape to share – to tape the stick to the cardstock Popsicle figures
- Bibles – one per child

Snack – Bible Book shaped snack such as rectangle shaped cheese or crackers – enough so each child gets some along with a napkin and a glass of water

Week 4:

- Attendance Charts –from previous class – one per student
- Shepherds Hear About Jesus Play Craft – one sheet per student cut out before class
- Scissors – to cut out Play Craft sheets before class
- Tape – to tape the Paper Craft together as needed
- Shepherd Paper Towel Template – two shepherds per student cut before class – 1 set on a page
- Empty paper towel cardboard rolls – 4-5 inches high approximately – 2 per student
- Tape to share
- Scissors – to cut out figures before class for those too young to cut and scissors to share
- Mary and Joseph and Baby Jesus and Sheep Paper Towel People – made from previous class

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Tactile Sheep Craft or Visual Aid – 1 sheep per student, 2 sheep on a page – page cut in half before class or if using as visuals – cut the sheep out completely one for each student.
- Small piece of terry cloth – one piece per student to glue onto sheep
- Cotton Balls – 1-2 per student to glue onto sheep tail
- Popsicle Sticks – one per student if using tactile sheep as visual aids
- Tape and Glue Sticks to share
- Shepherd Maze – one per student
- Shepherds Hear Color Page – one per student
- Dolls – one of each family member to show students during song – ex: dad, mom, baby....
- Bibles – one per child

Snack –Marshmallows – enough so each child gets some along with a napkin and a glass of water

Week 5:

- Attendance Charts –from previous class – one per student
- Wise Men Activity Sheet – one per student
- Stickers for Wise Men – 20 stickers on a page – 2 stickers per student
- Scissors – to cut out stickers before class
- Glue sticks and/or Tape to share
- Wise Men Bring Gifts Page – one per student
- Wise Men Bring Gifts Stickers – 3 stickers per student – one of each cut out before class

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Follow the Star to Jesus – print sheet on construction or cardstock paper and cut out one star per student – there are two stars on a page
- Popsicle Stick – one per student taped onto star
- Tape and Scissors – to cut star and tape stick to star before class

- Gold tissue paper, wrapping paper, or any pieces of paper that are yellow or gold colored to glue onto students stars
 - Glue sticks to share
 - Play dough – enough for each child
 - Bibles – one per child
- Snack – Star shaped crackers, cheese, or fruit pieces – enough for each student along with glass of water and napkin

Week 6:

- Attendance Charts –from previous class – one per student
- Simeon and Anna Activity Sheets – printed back to back or taped back to back – one set of activity sheets per student
- Simeon and Anna Stickers – one set per student, 3 sets on a page – cut out before class for activity
- Glue sticks to share
- Scissors – to cut out stickers before class
- Jesus Goes to the Temple with His Family Maze – one per student

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Jesus' Family goes to the Temple Color Page – one per student
- Stick Puppet People – one template page per student cut out before class
- Popsicle Sticks – 5 per student taped onto back of each puppet person
- Tape and Scissors – to cut and tape sticks to puppet people before or during class
- Bibles – one per child

Snack – Your choice – enough for each student along with glass of water and napkin

Week 7:

- Attendance Charts –from previous class – one per student
- We Thank God for Jesus Badge – one per student cut out before class
- We Thank God Stickers – one set per student, 18 sets on a page – cut out before class for activity
- String – enough to tie loosely around each students neck with a bow – one “necklace” per student
- Glue sticks to share
- Hole Punch to share (or if unavailable use scissors but only let an adult “punch” the holes)
- Scissors – to cut out stickers before class
- We Thank God for Jesus Banner Template – 1 per student – one sheet makes 4 banners
- Drinking Straw or Craft Stick – 12-16 inches long – one per student to use as the banner stick
- Tape to share
- Stickers – letter stickers or heart, bible, or prayer stickers to use to decorate banners – to share

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Jesus is God's Son Booklet – print one sheet per student, cut out book pages before class
- Scissors to cut out book pages from booklet sheet
- Stapler
- Bibles – one per child

Snack – Triangle Shaped Cheese and Pretzel Sticks (Mini-Banners) – enough for each student to have some along with glass of water and napkin

Week 8:

- Attendance Charts –from previous class – one per student
- Jesus' Family Moves Activity Sheet – one per student
- Jesus' Family Moves Stickers – one set per student – 4 sets on a page
- Pack for the Trip Suitcase – one per student printed on brown construction paper and folded in half then cut out before class
- Pack for the Trip Bible and Clothes Stickers – one set per student, 2 sets on a page, cut the page in half so each child gets a set – cut out stickers after students have colored them.
- Scissors for adult or older students to cut stickers and for suitcase
- Glue sticks to share

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Jesus' Family Moves Color Page (or Visual Aid) – one per student
- Angel, Mary and Joseph Popsicle stick people – from lesson 2 (one set for each student while you share the account of Jesus' family moving)
- Jesus' Family Moves Color and Drawing Sheet – one per student
- Jesus is Born Action Figures (taken from Lesson 3 – see instructions in lesson for how to print and set up if you did not do so from lesson 3 – use Mary and Joseph travelling along with little Jesus for students to play with during pretend play time) *You will need scissors and tape if making
- Play Dough – enough for each child
- Bibles – one per child

Snack – Trail Mix (travel mix of nuts and dried fruit) – enough for each student to have some along with glass of water and napkin *Check for nut allergies first!

Week 9:

- Attendance Charts –from previous class – one per student
- Jesus Grows Booklet – one per student
- Jesus Grows Stickers – one set per student – 6 sets on a page cut out before class
- Stapler to share
- Jesus Grows in Wisdom Sheet – one per student
- Jesus Grows in Wisdom Stickers – one per student – 5 on a page
- Scissors for adult or older students to cut stickers and/or booklet
- Glue sticks to share

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Jesus Grows in Wisdom Color Page (or Visual Aid) – one per student
- Dolls – family members such as dad, mom, boy, girl, baby – enough for students to share and pretend
- Bibles – one per child

Snack –Fruit or Vegetables – enough for each student along with glass of water and napkin

Week 10:

- Attendance Charts –from previous class – one per student
- Jesus Spinning Wheel Templates – one set per student - printed on construction or cardstock paper – cut before class
- Paper fastener or Brad – one per student
- Scissors for teacher or older students to cut out template
- I Will Obey Feet Template - one template for class to share

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Jesus Booklet – one per student cut out before or during class
- Scissors for teacher or older students
- Stapler to share
- Dolls of family members – enough for each child to have mom, dad and children to play with
- Bibles – one per child
- Snack – Your Choice – enough for each child along with a napkin and a glass of water

Week 11:

- Attendance Charts –from previous class – one per student

Valentine's Day Love Bugs

- Large Pom Poms – 2 per student
- Googly Eyes – 2 sets per student (or if unavailable cut out white small circles from paper and draw 2 black circles in the middle for eyes)
- Markers to share
- Chenille sticks or pipe cleaners – 1 per student cut into four equal pieces
- Scissors for teacher to cut pipe cleaners and/or heart templates
- Heart Template – one sheet printed on pink, red or white cardstock paper and cut out 15 on page OR
- Heart shaped craft foam shapes – 2 per student purchased at craft store
- Craft Glue or Glue sticks to share (Craft glue works best)

I Love God Just Like Jesus Craft

- Chenille sticks or pipe cleaners – 1 per student
- Pony Beads – 40 approximately per student – various colours (beads that have holes in the middle large enough to go through pipe cleaner)

Depending on time choose some optional activities to do and gather supplies

- Jesus Goes to the Temple Page – one per student or one per class if using as visual aid
- Dolls – family members such as dad, mom, boy, girl, baby – enough for students to share and pretend
- Bibles – one per child

Snack – Strawberry slices or cheese, cut into heart shape– enough for each student along with glass of water and napkin

- I Can Help Color Page – one per student
- Ways to Care Drawing Activity Sheet – one per student
- Play Dough – enough for each child
- Bibles – one per child
- Snack – Your Choice – enough for each child along with a napkin and a glass of water

- I Will Obey God Shoes Template – one per student printed on white construction or cardstock paper cut out before class
- Shoelaces or Yarn – Two pieces to tie in bows – one set for each student
- Scissors to share

- Rubber bands – Two per student
- I Will Obey Footprints Sheet - one per student
- Who is Obeying God Sheet – one per student
