**Week 1:**

- The Passover Color Page – one per young child and one for teacher to use as visual aid
- Fill in the Blanks Passover and Jesus Page – one per older child who can read and write

Optional:

- Path Scramble Activity Sheet – one per child
- Popsicle Sticks – 5 for every 2-4 children
- Blank Paper – one for every 2-4 children
- Different colored fine-tipped markers (one for every 2-4 children)
- Storybook or visuals of this story to show kids (if available)

Snack: Bread without yeast – ask the person who prepares communion to make some for your class or ask for the recipe to make yourself

- small piece for each child
- Napkins for snack one per child
- Juice or water and cup one per child

**Week 2:**

- Silver Trumpet Bible Verse Look Up – one per child
- Israelites Maze – one per child
- Map of Israel's Journey – one for class to share

Optional:

- 12 Tribes Word Search – one per child
- Storybook or visuals of this story to show kids (if available)

Snack: Horn Shaped Snack – either cheese slice, meat slice, tortilla wrap and/or waffle cone

- one piece for each child
- Napkins for snack one per child
- Juice or water and cup one per child

**Week 3:**

- Put the Pictures in Order – The Israelites and the Quail – one per student
- Handicaps of Complaints Sheet – one per student
- Small piece of paper – one per student
- Complaining Mouth Drawing Sheet – one per student
- Map of Israel's Journey – one for class to share

Optional:

Quail Quail Everywhere Hand Painting Activity

- Construction Paper – one sheet per student
- Shallow tray or paper plate – one for every 4 students
- Finger Paint or Chocolate Pudding – one for every 4 students
- Damp Paper Towels – enough to share to clean hands afterwards
- Men's long sleeve shirts or smocks or aprons – one per student to wear
- Black Markers – to share
- Feathers – enough so every child gets 10 or so

- Glue – enough to share for feathers

#### Handicap Game Supplies

- Bubble Gum – 5 pieces per student
- Soda Crackers – 5 crackers per student
- 20 Pens
- Sheet of Paper – one per student

- Twine or thin rope – enough for class to share
- Scissors to cut twine/rope

Snack: Boneless Cooked Chicken Pieces (Bite Sized) \*Keep cold 1-4 pieces for each child

- Napkins for snack one per child

- Juice or water and cup one per child

#### Week 4:

- Word Search
- Don't Fall into Temptation Craft Sheet – one per student printed onto white construction or cardstock paper
- Scissors to share
- String – 1 piece per child approximately 8 inches
- Hole Punch to share

#### Optional:

##### Don't Fall into Temptation Craft

- Cinnamon in sprinkle jar – enough to sprinkle on leaves
- White glue or glue sticks to share

##### Paper Cuts Activity Game

- Construction Paper – one sheet per student
- Scissors – one per student
- Tape – to share

- Storybook or visuals of this story to show kids (if available)

Snack: Strawberries cut into mouth shapes (see picture below) 1-4 pieces for each child

- Napkins for snack one per child

- Juice or water and cup one per child

#### Week 5:

- Map of 12 Spies Journey
- Rating Quiz – one sheet per student

#### Optional:

- Maze Sheet with Questions – one per student
- 12 Spies Color Page – one per student

##### Let's Make a Deal

- 1 dollar or chocolate bar – 2 of either chocolate bar or dollar
- Envelopes – 2
- 5 dollars – 2
- Chocolate bar or dollar for every student in the class who did not get one of the above prizes

- Storybook or visuals of this story to show kids (if available)

Snack: Grapes, Figs and/or Pomegranates 1-4 pieces for each child

- Napkins for snack one per child

- Juice or water and cup one per child

## Week 6:

- Word Maze – one per child

### Optional:

- 12 Spies Color Page – one per student
- Storybook of this story with pictures to show kids (if available) and/or
- Flannel Display Board with this story (if available)

### Obstacle Course

- Chairs
- Random objects to put as obstacles along path – blocks, stools, storage boxes, etc.
- Tables
- Blindfolds – one for every two students (Can use scarf, bandana, or sleep mask)
- Storybook or visuals of this story to show kids (if available)

### Butterfly Faith Craft

- Butterfly Template 1 – one page for every student (can use construction or cardstock paper)
- Butterfly Template 2 – one page for every student (can use construction or cardstock paper)
- Scissors – one per student
- Fishing line or thin string/yarn – one 20 inch piece per student
- Glue stick – to share
- Felt or construction paper scrap pieces – enough for each child to have pieces to decorate butterfly wings

- Snack: Grapes, Figs and/or Pomegranates 1-4 pieces for each child
- Napkins for snack one per child
  - Juice or water and cup one per child

## Week 7:

- Blue Yarn or String – one 8 inch piece for each child
- Scissors to share
- Blue Bracelet twine or if unavailable blue yarn or string – enough to wrap around each student's wrist and tie a knot
- Beads of various colors or ones that have letters to spell out words – enough for each child to make a design on their bracelet

### Optional:

- Storybook or visuals of this story to show kids (if available)

### Aroma of Christ Activity

- Sweet smelling thing: cinnamon, watermelon slices, vanilla, mint or something similar
- Strong smelling thing: lemon, basil, oregano, black pepper or something similar
- Bad smelling thing: dirt, cooked cabbage, old shoes or something similar

### Hangman

- Large writing surface – like easel with paper or chalkboard (to play hangman) or piece of paper to show children as you play hangman.
- Marker or pen

### Snack:

- Grapes, Figs and/or Pomegranates 1-4 pieces for each child
- Napkins for snack one per child
- Juice or water and cup one per child

## Week 8:

### Prayer Journals

- Construction or Cardstock Paper – various colors – one per student folded in half
- White paper – 10 pieces per student folded in half or cut in half
- Stapler or Hole Punch (if using hole punch also gather some string to tie a bow in each hole x 3)
- Scrap paper, felt, tissue, ribbons, or stickers to decorate cover of Prayer Journal
- Glue sticks to share
- Scissor to share

### Optional:

- Storybook or visuals of this story to show kids (if available)
- Pen or pencil to give to each child to use with their prayer journal

#### Blind Artist Game

- Blindfold – one per every two students – can use scarf, sleep mask, or bandana
- White paper – one per student
- Pencils to share

#### Snack:

- Grapes, Figs and/or Pomegranates 1-4 pieces for each child
- Napkins for snack one per child
- Juice or water and cup one per child

### Week 9:

- Fill in the Blank and Color Page Activity – one per student

#### Optional:

- Basket of Blessings Word Scramble – one per student
- Visual Aid of Aaron’s Rod and an Almond Branch – one for class to share
- Popsicle Sticks – 5 for every 2-4 children
- Blank Paper – one for every 2-4 children
- Different colored fine-tipped markers (one for every 2-4 children)
- Storybook or visuals of this story to show kids (if available)

#### Snack:

- Almonds \*Check for nut allergies first! handful for each child
- Napkins for snack one per child
- Juice or water and cup one per child

### Week 10:

- Color Page – one per younger student who cannot read or write well
- Moses Questions and Cross Word – one per older student who can read and write well

#### Optional:

- Small Rock
- Piece of Paper
- Pair of Scissors
- Water from the Rock God’s Power Demonstration Activity Supplies
- Three rocks – one of each small, medium and large
- Wooden stick – either a real wooden stick like a rod or a popsicle stick for example
- Bag to place rocks in
- List of Sins Activity
- Easel, Whiteboard or large piece of paper and a writing
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- Visual Aid of Moses Striking the Rock
- Storybook or visuals of this story to show kids (if available)

#### Snack:

- Pretzel Sticks (to mimic rod or staff) handful for each child
- Napkins for snack one per child
- Juice or water and cup one per child

### Week 11:

- Bronze Serpent Activity Sheet – one per student

#### Optional:

#### Cross Pin

- Safety pins (small) – 8 for every student
- Small seed beads - making sure opening is large enough to string onto safety pin – 2 various colors enough for each child to have 15-20 of one color and 40-50 of another color (amounts may vary depending on size of safety pin)

#### Believe in Jesus Now Craft

- Watch Template – one per student printed on white cardstock or construction paper
- Glue stick – to share
- Scissors – to share
- Brass fastener or Brad – one per student
- Storybook or visuals of this story to show kids (if available)

#### Snack:

- Pretzel Sticks (pole and/or snake) handful for each child
- Napkins for snack one per child
- Juice or water and cup one per child

### Week 12:

- Balaam and the Donkey Color the Dots Sheet – one per student
- Donkey Maze – one per student

#### Optional:

- Talking Donkey Craft
- Donkey Template – one per student printed on white cardstock or construction paper
- Popsicle Stick – one per student
- Tape – to share
- Scissors – to share
- Brass fastener or Brad – one per student
- Storybook or visuals of this story to show kids (if available)

#### Snack:

- Pretzel Sticks handful for each child
- Napkins for snack one per child
- Juice or water and cup one per child

### Week 13:

- Multiplication Riddle Sheet – one per older child
- Multiplication Table – one per student if no access to calculators. There are 4 tables on a page – cut out before class. – one per older child
- Color Page – one per younger child

#### Optional:

- Calculators to share – for those doing multiplication sheet if you did not print multiplication table
- Storybook or visuals of this story to show kids (if available)
